NOTES

Using the contact details above, please check details/times with the leader who will be able to advise on length, level of difficulty, availability of seats in cars etc. Walk details, bus/train times can change after we publish the programme – PLEASE CHECK.

Please remember that all walkers take part at their own risk and that they are responsible for their own safety.

Bring food and drink. Make sure you have a sufficient supply of liquid to avoid dehydration. Boots are recommended on all rambles. Have adequate rainwear.

Every walker is asked to carry details of whom to contact in case of emergency, also any relevant details of medication.

Car sharing – passengers are asked to contribute £2.50 per shorter journey towards costs. If the round trip is in excess of 30 miles, please contribute £3.50.

If you intend to join the walk anywhere other than at the published start, please discuss with the leader. Anyone wishing to leave the walk early must inform the leader before doing so.

In the event of an alteration to the published programme, including cancellation due to bad weather, we will do our best to contact you, but this cannot be guaranteed.

Please allow the leader to lead and don't get ahead. Equally try to keep together as a group. Where possible appoint a back marker.

Walkers are requested **not** to bring dogs on walks.

Members subscriptions (£7 per year) are due on Jan. 1st.

Leaders - please refer to the risk assessment guidelines when planning your walk.

Leaders are asked to bring a small first aid kit.
