The list represents the best scientific textbooks published in 2019 for students in kindergarten through 12th grade. This 2020 Outstanding Science Trade Books list includes titles that will captivate, educate and inspire children, building literacy skills through engaging science content, said NSTA Executive Director Dr. David Evans. These books are not read once. They include captivating stories, charming characters and vivid illustrations that will delight children and adults just as well. Members of a book review panel consisting of science educators and literacy professionals, appointed by NSTA, selected 43 books for the list from a roster of 347 entries. The list of winning titles includes topics ranging from robots to woolly monkeys. The review panel used strict guidelines to select the best books. Criteria include the amount of science content; the presentation of material in a clear, precise and up-to-date manner; avoiding over-simplification; the use of data to support generalisations; freedom of gender, ethnic and socio-economic bias. The panel also takes into account the correct level of content for the intended audience and the accuracy of illustrations. NSTA and CBC have collaborated on the list of Outstanding Science Trade Books for since 1973 in an effort to help science educators and family members access quality books that support learning in science. In addition to the NSTA and CBC websites CBC websites list will appear in the February numbers of NSTA's elementary, middle level, and high school journals for teachers. NSTA and CBC have joined forces on this bibliographic project since 1973, when the list was known as Outstanding Science Trade Books for Children and was primarily focused on grades K to 8.
