The DVD player installed in the car requires a remote control to access its functions. A faulty or lost remote control that comes with a DVD player can be replaced by a universal remote control. The universal remote can be purchased from a pharmacy or hobby store and will have access to all THE functions of the DVD player as soon as it has been programmed.
