A: You can't save one model from another instance. But you can reuse instances you've already retrieved. Here is one of many examples that do that: `from django.db.models import Q from django.db.models import get_model A.objects.annotate(last_id=Max('id')).filter(Q(last_id=1) | Q(last_id=2)) A.objects.create(id=1) A.objects.create(id=2)` In this example, it first gets all the A objects with `id` equal to 1 or 2, then save the first and last A objects (whichever appears first in the query above), and then save the last A `520f0b1ae7`
