There's just something about gorgeous linen and napkins all stacked really like what makes my desk so very happy. I've been experimenting with napkin folds for the past few years and slowly, but of course I'm laying them all out here. Last year I shared one of my favorite easy wipe creases (shown below). If you are a true visual, in real life, kind of person head to see the video for this simple swipe times. Throughout the year, as I pop into thrift stores and yard sales, I pick up laundry for pennies on the dollar. I like to change my tablecloths for different seasons. It adds such a festive touch. Pinwheel swipe times that I share today are perfect for all kinds of parties. It is ideal for both children's parties and adults. Crispy stroked and just stacked on a plate, they can really look elegant, but as you know, ironing isn't my forte, so rest assured, the slightly wrinkled napkins work beautifully, and here are the directions that I've been trying to line up with my photos. 1. Fold four corners into the center. 2. Fold the top edge and bottom edge into the center. 3. Bring the left and right sides in the center. 4. Find each of the four free corners in the center and gently pull them aside to form four points. This is the hardest part and can take several times to understand the process, but once you do, you'll laugh that you couldn't understand it right away. (Ask me how I ;). 5. Fold the bottom left to the left and the top right point to the right. Feel free to decorate the top of the napkin with any trinkets you may have around the house. I cut some holly from our bush for a festive Christmas touch, and after I finished taking these photos, I experimented with some stellar ornaments that looked adorable as well. If I used this napkin times for kids party, patterned, colorful napkins would be as much fun as well. I'm ending up with the true reality of my kitchen table at the moment. It's amazing how bloggers can cut and harvest everything to look just perfect when we know the true reality of bedlam mess around the edges of the camera lens. ☺

Pinwheel is a fun time that looks fantastic on the table. Especially popular for children, napkin times works especially well with slightly starched cotton or linen napkins. Swipes for this folding style: White Hemstitched linen dinner Wipes Ecru Hemstitched linen dinner Napkins Directions on how to fold a napkin Step1Iron napkin napkin Step2Fold all tips the wipes in the center of Step3Fold two opposite edges to the center, creating a rectangleStep4Fold two short rectangle edges to the center ofStep5Now to take one flap and pull one out of the edges to make a point. Step6Repeat with the second flapStep7C right valve, pull it down to youStep8Turn swipes around and repeat the steps 5-6 to finish the pinwheel swipe times. You can use any color bandanas or napkins to make these pinwheel napkins place settings to make the possibilities endless! For our last barbecue I paired this pinwheel napkin with a mason jar to create a cute and easy barbecue place setting on our picnic table themed spread. Another great way to add flair to the barbecue is to string some lights around the deck like patio string lights from Christmas lights, etc. you don't need anything fancy to throw a fun barbecue party and these pinwheel napkins are a very inexpensive way to add a lot of flair to your table. Once you know how to fold a pinwheel napkin it's not hard! Step 1: Spread the napkin or bandana on the table. Step 2: Fold each corner to form a square. Step 3: Fold in each outer edge to form a rectangle. Step 4: Fold at the top and fold from below to make it look like the picture above. Step 5: Pull the triangular crease out of the bottom right corner. Step 6: Fold the opposite angle to make it look the same. Step 7: Fold the right triangle. Step 8: Turn to the opposite side, so the side you just worked on is now on top. Step 9: Repeat the same steps as above, pulling each triangle out of each corner. For my casual yellow-and-black summer table, I used lemon-yellow napkins made of bright tweaks paired with a black and white gingham check tablecloth. I love this pinwheel napkin once so much that I used it for our hot dog toppings bar, too. To do this, I used paper napkins to check the picnic. Really any square napkin will work! I added a little ring of napkins to the yellow wheels. It's really just clip-on earrings tucked into the center. The button or decorative pin will also work.
