Afghan Tajik

Lord Jesus, we pray for the Afghan Tajik people who are living in a nation struggling with political turmoil. You see their hearts and know the truth that only you can give when we embrace you and believe. Open up the door of salvation and

Hui

Lord, we turn to you in prayer today on behalf of the Hui people in China. With hearts devoted to your Word and longing to be connected to your truth, please open the eyes, ears, minds and hearts of the Hui people so that they may seek after Your son Jesus Christ and give their lives to You. Help them overcome language barriers and all other challenges that may stand between them and a saving knowledge of You. May the Chinese believers nearby be bold in their witness for Jesus by presenting the Gospel in a way that honors You and speaks of Your love for us all. Give them strength as they courageously seek a disciple-making movement among these lost souls so that many more may come to know Your forgiveness, grace and eternal blessings through Your Son on the cross. In this we pray according to your will, Amen.

Lord, we come before You today lifting up the nation of China and in particular those of the Hui people group. According to Your Word in Psalm 46:1, "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble," so we pray for help and protection for those who have yet to believe in You and receive salvation in Jesus. Please create a deep desire within each heart and soul for spiritual truth that will lead them to seek after You through their Christian neighbors.

Turn the hearts of the Chinese believers towards this unreached people group; guide them to whatever it takes to introduce Your Son Jesus Christ in order for these Muslims to hear Your saving grace. May His love be demonstrated daily as we continue to call on Your name, that a strong disciple-making movement will begin to grow amongst this population throughout all areas of social life, both near and far. For only through Jesus are sins forgiven, separated by time no longer but redeemed at the Cross and invited into eternal life with Him where true peace lies. Amen.

Kazakh

O Lord, we turn to You in prayer for the Kazakhs of China, who have not yet received the Gospel and remain unreached by light of Your truth. We come before You asking that You would touch these 1,887,000 with Your love and mercy as they search for hope and healing. May Your Spirit move among them, softening hearts so that they will be eager to receive and believe in Jesus' saving grace. Open their eyes that they may see the power of the cross lifted up in faith—for apart from lifting their eyes to You Jesus said none but those doeth truth can enter heaven (John 3:21). Pour out Your Holy Spirit among them that there would arise strong local churches where those believing may come together faithfully and continuously seek Your Word in joy.

We pray specifically for long-term laborers to be sent to share Your love and proclaim a message of redemption and salvation through forgiveness of sins through Jesus Christ. In His precious name we pray; Amen.

Heavenly Father, we ask you to look down upon the unreached Kazakh people of China and lead them to Your truth and salvation. Help our brothers and sisters find freedom in You, Lord Jesus. Through Your mercy, may they see that their sins are forgiven on the cross, so that their souls will be released from bondage and shall receive the redemption that You offer freely and graciously. Help us spread Your Word so that more from this people group will turn to You and believe in You. According to Isaiah 52:7 “How beautiful on the mountains, are the feet of those who bring good news”—we pray for You to send long-term laborers among the Kazakhs to share Your love with them. We fully trust in Your power, knowing that no weapon formed against us could ever prosper as it is written in Isaiah 54:17; I ask for a miracle of conviction in these hearts so that they may recognize Your truth and accept the grace of baptism into faith. Uyghurs

Lord Jesus, we come before you today and pray for the Uyghur people of China. Over 11 million Uyghurs live in this nation, and although many have yet to hear of Your truth, Your life-giving love, and Your message of forgiveness through the cross; we know that redemption is available for all who believe.

We ask that You would bring an outpouring of grace into their suffering and open their eyes to You. Let Han Chinese Christians lead by example, showing the compassion of Christ to their Uyghur brothers and sisters so that they can understand that salvation can be found in no other Name but Jesus. Protect over those who are being detained in internment camps - we lift up the prayers of all Uyghur men, women and children who wrongfully suffer at the hands of persecution and injustice. Draw near to the Uyghur today in loving kindness and compassion towards those who are bearing much suffering.

May Holy Spirit breath life into their souls with knowledge of Jesus as their Savior and provide them peace even in the midst of great turmoil. Bible promises us if we believe on You, Jesus, You will take away all our sins, shame and sorrow; so Lord Jesus, would you please listen to their cries and forgive those who turn to You in repentance?

Almighty God, we come to you humbly today in prayer for guidance and wisdom as we consider the Ansari people group who presently remain unreached by the truth of your word. We pray that you will reveal yourself to them Lord, that through your grace they may find forgiveness and redemption.

Lord, bless those faithful believers who share your love with others, encourage them to continue sharing the gospel with those they come in contact with. Open up the hearts of the Ansari people to accept Jesus as their Savior and Redeemer. Through belief in him- and in his death on the Cross - may they be radically transformed from a life of sin and darkness into one that is rooted in Your love, Your mercy and Your grace. May all of our efforts lead them to a deeper understanding of Jesus so that together we can make every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord of all according to Philippians 2:10-11. Amen

Bania

Lord, we raise our hands and our hearts to you in prayer for the Bania people. We thank you for loving them and seek your guidance and mercy as we seek to reach them with Your truth and Your salvation. Lord, help us believe that "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved" (Romans 10:13). Heavenly Father, please forgive us for not bringing Jesus to these people as soon as possible and reach them with His promise of eternal life through His death on the cross. Please give us courage to speak His Word faithfully across India so even this unreached people can hear about You. We pray that their spiritual hunger will lead them closer to You and that believers would start planting churches among them so many more can come to experience Your forgiveness and eternal life through Jesus. Dhobi

Lord, have mercy on the Dhobi people of India who are still unreached by Your truth. We ask that You provide access to better education and vocational opportunities so they can engage in meaningful work in our modern world. Most importantly, oh Lord, we pray that many will come to You through faith in Jesus Christ and His redeeming power on the cross. Open their eyes to the truth that only Jesus can forgive their sins and bring salvation. Guard their hearts against any spiritual hunger they struggle with apart from You, so they may fully experience Your goodness when they believe in Your Son's death and resurrection for them. With a population of nearly 12 million and speaking chiefly in Hindi, they remain largely unreached by Your gospel. Jesus was sent so that no one would have to remain separated from You and still our brothers and sisters living among the Dhobi can see truth revealed only through You. We pray for their salvation by believing in the forgiveness You offer through the cross. Lord, open the hearts of this precious people group to receive You and Your gift of salvation with understanding and faith as we faithfully share Your Word from the depths of our own souls. Lift them toward freedom and justice, born again in mercy and grace, shielded from darkness and unknowingness by only trusting in You, Lord Jesus Christ. Amen



Jat

Almighty Father, we come to You today with a burden of love for the Jat people. We ask that You open their hearts to receive the truth and Word of Jesus, so that they may be saved through repentance and by believing in Him that died on the cross for their sins. Guide those you send to share this invaluable gift of salvation with them, giving them faith and courage no matter how difficult it is. Blessing those humanitarian workers and missionaries who devote their lives to bring Your light into darkness. Help every believer among them to spread Your Good News of redemption and forgiveness as far radiating from India where more than 29 million Jats call home. Let their number increase greatly as more find Your truth and give praises unto Your name forever. We thank You for all that You have done in their lives and pray for a greater understanding of Your truth to be revealed. Kapu

We pray for those living in villages with lack of modern medicine and electricity, that their spiritual and physical needs are met through our Lord Jesus. Help us to believe that there is forgiveness for our sins on the cross. Lead Indian believers to them and guide their conversations as they share about Your grace, salvation, and glory with the Kapu people. Although Hinduism is the prevalent religion there, we pray to You that believers from India will go to Kapu and share the truth of Your word so that they may be saved by Jesus. To not only have their spiritual needs met through salvation, but to have their physical needs met as well such as access to modern medicine, electricity and clean water.

Lord, forgive the sins of those who haven't yet heard of Your grace and love so that they too can find peace at the foot of the cross through faith in Jesus Christ. Amen.

Kumhar

Almighty and ever-loving God, we come to you in prayer today on behalf of the Kumhar people of India. Send us into their lives with a spirit of truth, humility and mercy. Give us the courage to share your good news – that Jesus came to earth so that whoever believes in Him has eternal life. We pray that You would open their hearts to the truth of Your Word, and ignite within them a spiritual hunger for You and for Your Son, Jesus Christ. Help them understand Your great sacrifice that was made at the cross, and enable them to receive that amazing gift of forgiveness for all their sins. Everything they are seeking can be found in You, forever secure in the promises of our all-loving God. We ask that You send out workers to help those among this people with both their physical needs and spiritual neediness so that they may come to believe in Jesus more firmly and deeply than ever before. May a disciple-making movement grow and thrive within the Kumhar community this decade so that many may be blessed through hearing the Good News of salvation brought by Jesus Christ our Savior. Amen.

Kunbi

Heavenly Father, we thank you for the Kunbi people and their rich heritage. We pray that you will guide them to the truth of Jesus Christ, just as you have done for so many Christians before them. May your word be proclaimed throughout their lands and that they receive your message with open hearts. We also ask that Christian workers will be called to serve among the Kunbi, helping to bring physical and spiritual aid to this unreached people group.

With your love and grace, dear Lord, may the hearts of these men and women become awakened to yours great acts of mercy and believe in the forgiveness found at your cross. Guide them in all ways towards salvation, so that they may come to know you as their Lord and Savior. Almighty God, we praise and honor your mighty name and thank you for the salvation you have promised through your son, Jesus. We bring before you the Kunbi unreached people group situated in India who speak Gujarati. Lord, we ask for a resurgence of your Spirit over these people and that more may come to know of your love and seek after you with all their hearts. Place upon their lips the same words from the Bible which once moved Saul to his knees – "Who are You, Lord?" that they may recognize that Jesus is Truth and be drawn forth by its power. Let not their unbelief keep them from having faith to believe on Jesus and be forgiven of their sins on His cross. Grant grace so that many more would understand your Word and come back to you with repentant hearts. In Jesus' mighty Name we pray - Amen!

Mahratta

O Lord, we pray that the truth of your Word and the hope that comes through Your Son Jesus may reach the unreached Mahratta peoples of India.

We ask for forgiveness of their sins and that they may come to believe in the power of Your love and mercy. As this people group who worships Hinduism makes up more than 31 million individuals spread across India, our heart is to pray that they receive salvation in Jesus.

As believers in Him, we pray they will follow His example of acceptance and admire all those God has created be it from a rural or upper class status. May the beauty, grace, and strength of You cross draw them towards You, O Lord, as we turn to Psalm 145:4 which states "one generation shall commend your works to another, and shall declare Your mighty acts". Amen.

Heavenly Father, we come to You today with a plea for Your children the Mahratta people. They live in India where they are found predominantly among the upper rural class, many families cultivating land and raising farm crops. There is no hope apart from You – Jesus said "I am the way and the truth and the life; no one comes to the Father but by Me" (John 14:6). We pray that this unreached people group will find forgiveness for their sins through believing in Jesus Christ, who died on the cross for our offenses. Help us together to open up our minds to understand Your Holy Word and to have true faith in You, so that we may receive Your free gift of salvation through Him.

Offer us protection as we travel this path of redemption and show us how to turn away from worshiping false idols and instead accept Your truth. In Your grace, Lord, hear our prayer for these Mahratta people and may they find true hope only in You. Amen.

Nai

Heavenly Father, we pray for the Nai, an unreached people group located in India who primarily practice Hinduism and number over 11 million. Lord Jesus, be our shield and help us to guard against Satan's lies so that truth can be spoken into their lives through your Word, the Bible. Unblock their ears to messages of salvation which will bring them forgiveness and deliverance from their sins. May they come to know the power you experienced on the cross when you willingly died for us. Guide them to turn away from falsehoods and towards your truth, believing firmly that only in you will they find love and hope. We confidently call on your name, trusting that if we believe in you nothing is impossible. Amen

Almighty God, we come to You with humble hearts, grateful for the wondrous works of redemption and salvation that Jesus Christ has brought. We pray that you would use us to bring Your hope to those who belong to the Nai people in India. May they learn Your

truth through Your Word, becoming enlightened and drawn to You. Reveal Yourself as only You can, Lord God, so that they will understand your unwavering love and grace and believe in Jesus for forgiveness of their sins and freedom from bondage. May the cross become an inspiration for all who are unreached and draw them closer into a loving relationship with you. Open their eyes and hearts so they recognize Your truth amidst darkness in this time and place. Pour out Your Spirit on them from Heaven, creating a disciple-making movement amongst them in this decade. Amen!

Rajput

Lord, help us to remember the Rajput community living in India, speaking Hindi and largely following Hinduism - 45.6 million people who don't know Your saving grace. Help us to remember that every person is a creation of Yours and a recipient of Your love and forgiveness, no matter their religious beliefs or spiritual state. Strengthen our faith in Your Word and remind us that "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish but have everlasting life" (John 3:16). Give respect and value to each Rajput so they can come to understand their need for Jesus.

Let them know that through what happened at the cross we can be saved and forgiven for all of our sins if we just believe. Amen.

We thank you for the 45 million Rajputs and ask that they would come to know the truth of Jesus. We pray that they will hunger to hear the Word and be transformed by it. May they come to believe in Jesus as their Savior, that their sins may be forgiven through His death on the cross. Lord, You are the Good Shepherd and King of Kings who knows each and every one of us intimately - let your royal family in Heaven grow with hearts willing to follow You and accept your grace. As Paul writes in Romans 10:9-10, "That if you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord', and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. Please send believers among them to spread the good news about redemption through Jesus Christ, so these unreached Indians might find forgiveness in You and eternal life. Open hearts and minds on a wide scale within this area of India, as only by believing in You will they taste salvation of their souls. Amen.

Lord, we come to you and humbly lift up the Teli people to You. We know that in them is a longing for truth, and only You fulfill that longing. Provide for Your people, that they may hear the Word of God and find salvation in Jesus's name. Bring about forgiveness for their sins and bowing of the knee at Your cross. Let this people group who are still unreached understand and believe the truth of your gospel. Surround them with believers who are strong in their faith and who can use the power of scripture to reach out more Teli people with your message of love and redemption. Open eyes, hearts, and minds so they may all know Jesus as their personal Lord and Savior. Amen

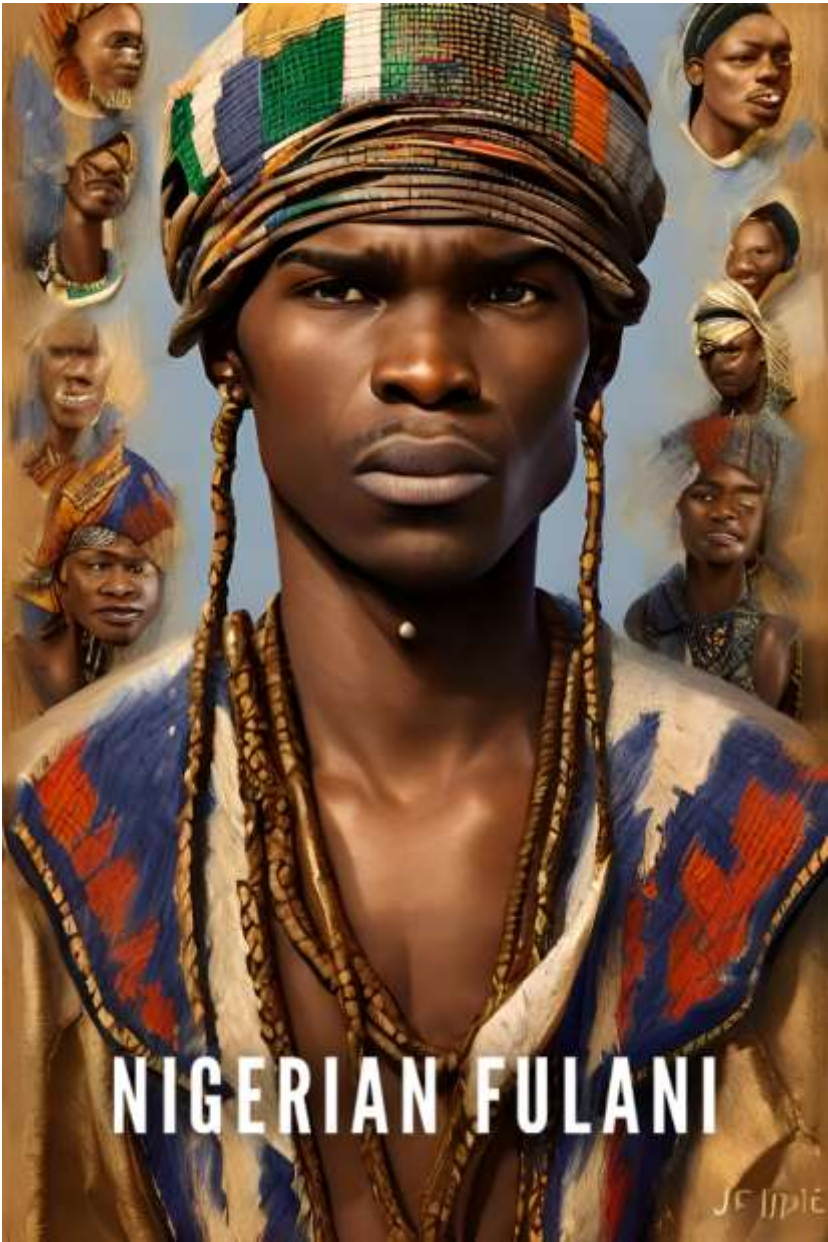

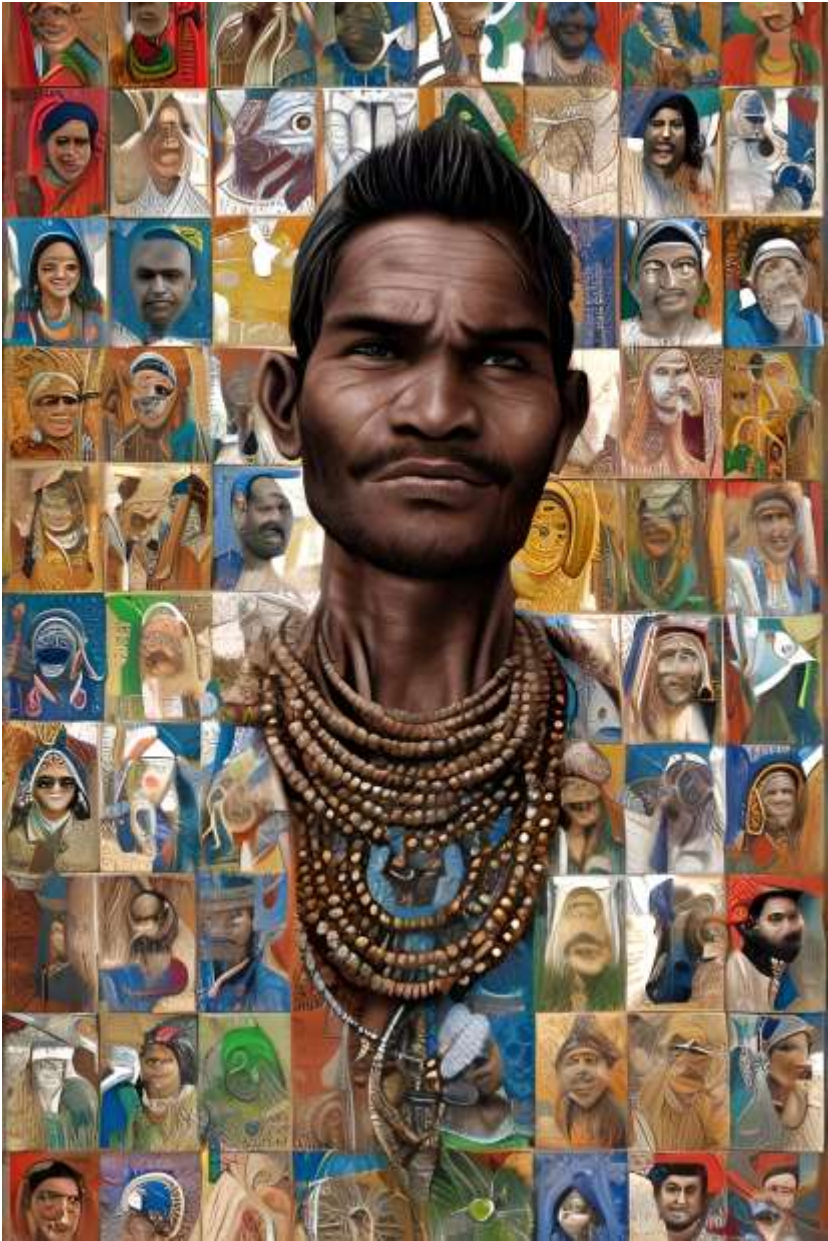

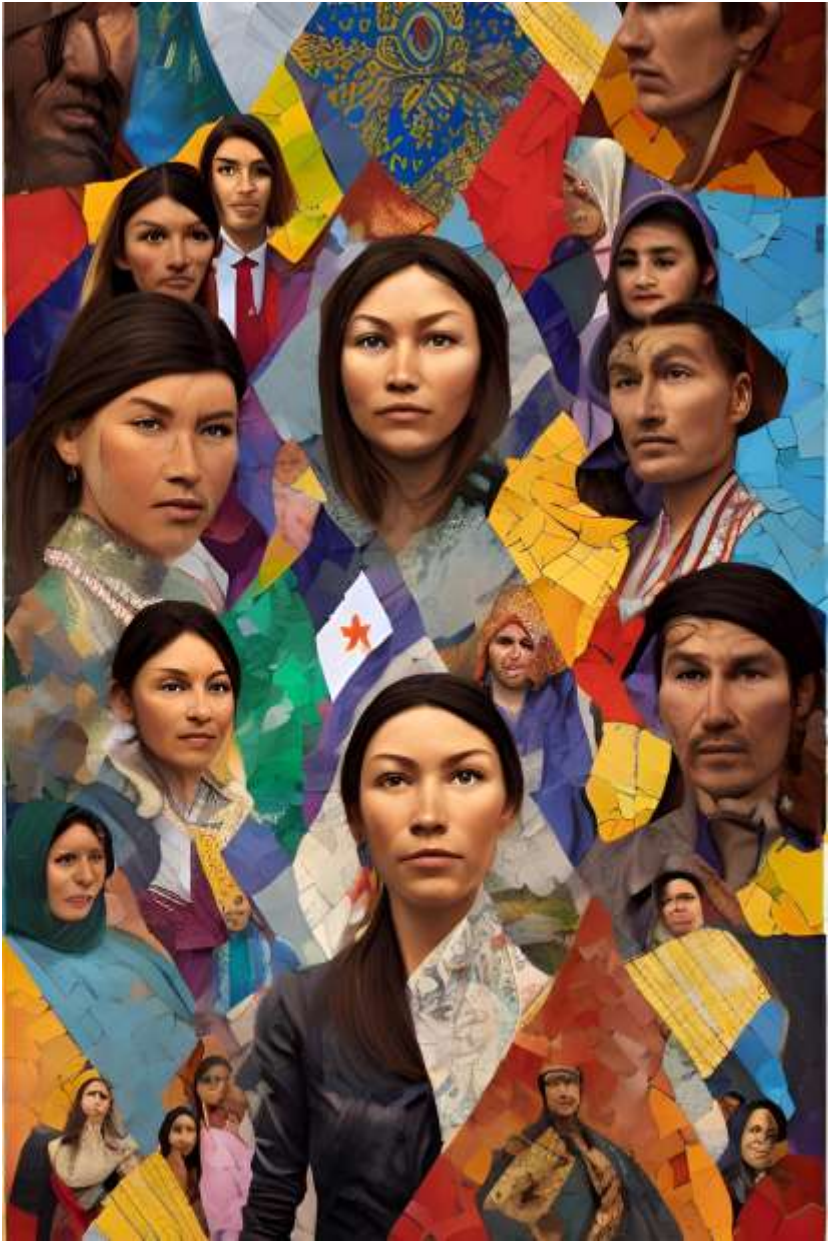
Arab Northern Yemeni

Has Everyone Heard?

One might occasionally hear the assertion that "Certainly, most everyone has heard of Jesus by now. Surely, missionaries have been sent to every country. Haven't we just about completed the Great Commission?" Despite the remarkable and almost miraculous spread of Christianity, there remain vast segments of the world's population who have never heard the name of Jesus, let alone received a clear presentation of the message of salvation.

Countries or Nations?

Although the Gospel has reached every political country in the world, it's essential to understand that when Jesus instructed His followers to "make disciples of all the nations" in Matthew 28:18-20, He was not referring to political entities like Canada, Kenya, Russia, and others. Some of these modern nations, such as the United States, did not even exist at the time of Jesus' command. The Greek word used by Jesus for "nations" is "ethne," from which we derive the English word "ethnic." In this context, "ethne" can refer to any non-Jewish person (Gentile) or a group of individuals sharing a common identity.

Efforts to reach these distinct ethnic communities remain an essential task for fulfilling the mission Jesus entrusted to His followers.

In the Great Commission, Jesus commanded His followers to make disciples from every ethnic people group, meaning every distinct cultural community.

This distinction has a profound impact when considering the scope of the Great Commission. For instance, let's consider Nigeria as an example:

Nigeria as a single political country.

Nigeria as a collection of over 540 distinct people groups, each requiring a church planting movement tailored to their unique cultural context.

Mission strategists define a people group as "a significantly large grouping of individuals who perceive themselves to have a common affinity for one another because of their shared language, religion, ethnicity, residence, occupation, class or caste, situation, etc., or combinations of these." For evangelistic purposes, it is "the largest group within which the gospel can spread as a church planting movement without encountering barriers of understanding or acceptance." (Ralph Winter p. 536) Current data suggests there are about 17,400 distinct people groups when considering country boundaries.

The Great Commission is far from complete, as there are still numerous unreached people groups waiting to hear the message of salvation.

Reached vs. Unreached: Bridging the Gap

An unreached people group refers to a community where no indigenous believers are present to evangelize and spread the message of Christianity. In the mid-1990s, mission strategists aimed to quantify this concept, settling on criteria for unreached status: less than 2% true Christ-followers and less than 5% professing Christians (encompassing all Christian denominations). While these percentage thresholds may seem somewhat arbitrary, we must not underestimate the profound impact a small group of people with a vision for a just and compassionate world can have. As Robert Bellah eloquently put it, "The quality of a whole culture may be changed when two percent of its people have a new vision." This quote, originally from *Psychology Today* in the 1970s, remains relevant even in today's *Christianity Today* (Oct 2011: 42).

Currently, estimates suggest that approximately 7,400 ethnic people groups are still classified as unreached. This means that over 40% of the world's people groups lack an indigenous Christian community capable of evangelizing their own people.

An astounding 42% of the global population resides within these over 7,400 unreached people groups.

Let's consider some startling facts about the 50 largest unreached people groups:

All 50 of these groups have less than 2% Christ-followers among their populations.

Individuals within these groups may have extremely limited or no access to the Gospel.

These 50 unreached people groups consist of a staggering 1.48 billion individuals.

One in five people worldwide belongs to these 50 unreached peoples.

Each group's population exceeds 10,000,000. None of these 50 groups have an indigenous church capable of spreading the Gospel throughout their community.

In terms of primary religion, 26 are Muslim, 17 Hindu, 5 Buddhist, 1 follows Ethnic Religions, and 1 identifies as non-Religious.

It's noteworthy that all 50 of these largest unreached people groups are situated within the 10/40 Window, and 47 of them are in politically sensitive countries.

It's important to clarify that an unreached people group doesn't necessarily imply that every individual within that group has never heard of Jesus or the message of salvation. In some cases, a small percentage (less than 2%) of Christ-followers might exist within these groups. Nevertheless, the vast majority remains largely unaware of Jesus Christ and the Good News of God's salvation, with minimal exposure to these concepts.

Take, for instance, the 135,000,000 unreached Shaikh of Bangladesh, the 59,000,000 unreached Brahman of India, the 58,000,000 unreached Yadav of India, or the 37,000,000 unreached Java Pesisir Lor of Indonesia. The majority of individuals within these groups, along with thousands of other unreached people groups, are completely ignorant of the King of Kings.

Lastly, "unengaged" denotes that there are absolutely no missionaries and, most likely, no outreach, churches, Christian materials, and very few, if any, Bibles available in these people groups.

The gap between reached and unreached remains wide, calling for concerted efforts to bridge it and share the message of hope and love with all corners of the world.

Unreached and Unengaged Ethnic Groups

According to data from the International Mission Board (IMB) of the Southern Baptist Convention, the world's largest denominational mission board, there may be over 3,000 ethnic people groups that are not only unreached but completely unengaged. This means that there is no known active on-site church planting effort underway, and there are very few, if any, believers among them. However, the Finishing the Task initiative suggests that this number might be lower than previously estimated.

It is deeply troubling to consider that, even after 2,000 years since Jesus issued the Great Commission, numerous people groups remain without any witness amidst them. To label a people group as unengaged signifies the absence of missionaries, likely no outreach efforts, no established church or fellowship of believers, and scarce Christian materials and Bibles in their midst. While it's possible that the Lord has worked supernaturally among some unengaged groups without outside involvement, it is not the typical way to spread of the Gospel.

He commanded the Church to go and share the message. Unfortunately, there are millions of individuals belonging to these unengaged people groups who have never heard of Jesus or His redemptive work.

Challenges in Bible Translation and Limited Access

To create true disciples, the Bible must be accessible in the native tongue of the people. Sadly, about 1,800 languages lack any form of translated Scripture, leaving millions without access to the Word of God. Moreover, illiteracy and oral learning pose further challenges, particularly in regions with concentrated unreached populations, where access to the Gospel remains scarce.

Limited Contact and Resource Imbalance

Interactions between Christians and non-Christians are limited, especially in certain regions like Asia, where contact rates are significantly lower. Furthermore, there is a significant imbalance in resource allocation, with over 90% of missionaries working among already reached peoples, leaving less than a penny of every Christian resource directed towards the unreached.



The Urgent Call

Despite advancements in the spread of Christianity, the reality is that a substantial portion of the global population remains unevangelized and without knowledge of Jesus Christ. The task of reaching all unreached people groups remains before us, and as

believers, we must rise to this challenge, fueled by the promise that every nation, tribe, people, and language will eventually worship God.

Joining the Historic Mission

In conclusion, we are at a critical moment in history, where the opportunity to shine the light of the gospel on every people group is within reach. Ralph Winter's call to "disciple all the nations" echoes through time, urging us to be part of this momentous mission and declare His glory among the nations. Let us embrace this call and work diligently to bring the message of salvation to those who have not yet heard.

The Great Imbalance

In the parable of the Lost Sheep the shepherd leaves the 99 and seeks out the one. He uses all his resources to find the lost. It seems the priority is backwards with the vast majority of Christian resources being used to tend the flock and few being used to seek the lost. Over 90% of all missionaries work among already reached peoples. For every dollar of Christian resources less than one penny is directed at reaching unreached peoples.

According to data presented by Operation World, the growth rate of Christianity, including Evangelicals, reached its peak in the mid-1990s but has since slowed down significantly. Despite numerous efforts to spread the Gospel, a sobering fact remains: approximately 24-27% of the world's population, which is close to two billion individuals, have not had the opportunity to hear the good news and respond meaningfully to it.

"The Future of the Global Church" highlights the issue of the unevangelized, noting that while the percentage of unevangelized people has decreased, the absolute number has increased. It is estimated that nearly 2 billion individuals still lack the chance to hear the Gospel.

The "Atlas of Global Christianity," using the World Christian Database's definition of an "evangelized person," identifies over 2 billion individuals in the category of "World A," which refers to the unevangelized.

In light of these facts, the need to reach out to the remaining unreached peoples and accomplish the challenge of "discipling all the nations" is emphasized. The goal is to bring the light of the Gospel to every people group on the planet, as foretold in Scripture, and to be part of this historic effort in declaring God's glory among all nations.

As Ralph Winter aptly stated, there is great momentum to accomplish this task like never before in history. The call is made to participate in this important mission and play a role in the worship of God by people from every nation, tribe, people, and language.

There is a pressing need to continue efforts to spread the Gospel and ensure that every individual, including those in remote and overlooked regions like Yemen, has the opportunity to hear the message of salvation.
