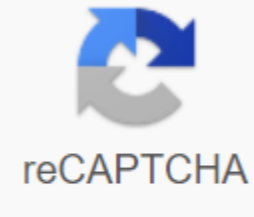

Where does archived gmail go

Then click the archive or delete whatever you want to the default action will be. Deleted messages only stay in the bin for 30 days before being permanently deleted. Then you can scroll to confirm the action and choose if you want to click confirm the archive or delete something. Then in the general mailbox and swipe right or left to archive the message depending on what you choose. So, in reality, archiving allows you to tidy up your inbox by moving messages from your inbox to the All Mail label, so you don't have to delete anything. When done writing, click Send archive to send a reply and archive the previous message in one step, or click Send send your reply, but leave the original message in the mailbox.
