



ABLE 2021 CRIMINAL JUSTICE SCHOLARSHIP

Below is a list of the requirements that are necessary to apply for the ABLE Criminal Justice Scholarship of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00).

1. The applicant must indicate the area of criminal justice they are pursuing and must denote it in a resume.
2. The applicant must be a senior and currently registered at an accredited public high school, charter school or currently attending a college or university.
3. The applicant must have a minimum of a 2.5 grade average which must be verified by the presentation of the most immediate past grades.
4. The applicant must be an Arizona resident and describe their financial need in the resume.
5. The applicant must write a descriptive essay, no less than two hundred and fifty words, double spaced, and elaborate on **an area where the criminal justice industry has been effective; and also expound on an area where the criminal justice industry can improve; and document a practical solution(s) which can rectify it.**
6. The issuing of this scholarship is based upon the applicant's acceptance into an accredited college or university.
7. Spouses or family members of the ABLE Board of Directors or the ABLE Steering Committee can not apply for this scholarship.

Mail the attached application, your resume and your essay to the address listed on the third page of this document. No emails will be accepted.
