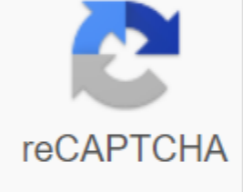

The song, which features Bon Iver, is about two ex-presidents reflecting on their failed relationship. I'm not your problem anymore / So who am I offending now? / You were my crown, now I'm in exile, seein' you / I think I've seen this movie before / So I leave behind the side door , Swift sings. Images such as a cardigan, disco ball and a swing tree filled Swift's mind during isolation, she wrote. The musician explained that over time these visions became clearer, which led to their formation in history. I found myself not only writing my own stories, but also writing about or from the perspective of people I've never met, people I've known, or those I wish I hadn't,' Swift wrote. -Taylor Swift (@taylorswift13) July 24, 2020In the last great American dynasty, a musician tells the story of Rebecca Harkness, a socialite who lived in Swift's home in Rhode Island. She switches gears and tracks the teenage love triangle from three perspectives in songs by Cardigan, August and Betty. The stories in her songs reflect traditional folklore, in which she said that the boundaries between fantasy and reality blur and the boundaries between truth and fiction become almost indistinguishable. Thus, regret at one and grief in Exile may not be part of Swift's personal narrative. There appear to be a few positive nods to Alwyn at Folklore Although earlier tracks drew fans' concerns about the state of Swift's relationship, they shouldn't look further than the Invisible Line for Easter Eggs about Alwyn.
