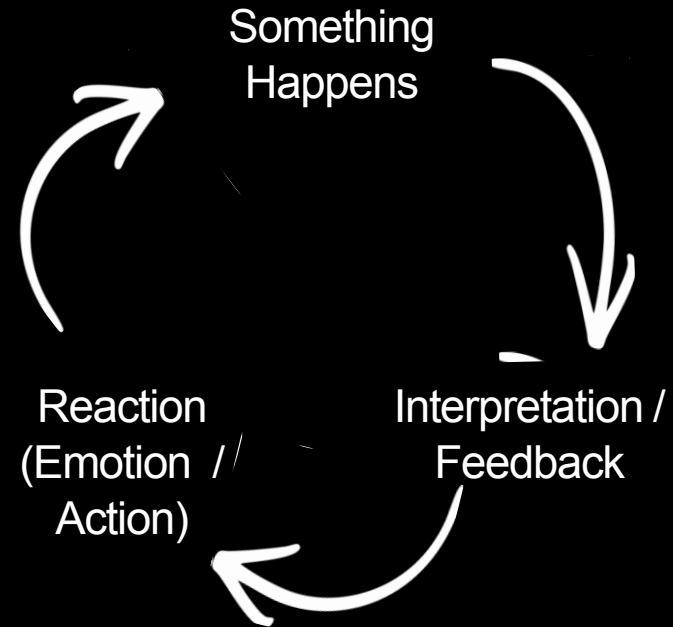

THE PSYCHOLOGY OF REACTION



“Complaining” is a form of reaction.

Usually comes from unmet expectations



WHY WE COMPLAIN

EASE THE DISCOMFORT

TEMPORARY EMOTIONAL

SEEK VALIDATIONS

RESTORING A SENSE OF
CONTROL

PROTECTING OUR PRIDE



SUBCONSCIOUS EFFECT OF COMPLAINING

“It’s not my fault”	→	“It’s God’s fault!!!”
Weakens Gratitude	→	“God owes me an explanation”
Less Trust & Faith	→	“I don’t like you God... :(”

THE GOOD APPEAL

The morality of the complaint is largely determined by its posture and outcome.

Psalm 13^[a]

For the director of music. A psalm of David.

- 1 How long, LORD? Will you forget me forever?
How long will you hide your face from me?
- 2 How long must I wrestle with my thoughts
and day after day have sorrow in my heart?
How long will my enemy triumph over me?
- 3 Look on me and answer, LORD my God.
Give light to my eyes, or I will sleep in death,
4 and my enemy will say, "I have overcome him,"
and my foes will rejoice when I fall.
- 5 But I trust in your unfailing love;
my heart rejoices in your salvation.
- 6 I will sing the LORD's praise,
for he has been good to me.
