Primeing comes forward: A flexible surface will be created using gesso that gets the paint well and allows you to spread it more effectively. Lanfranco underlines the content for this process, Gesso, a gesso brush and sandpaper (include sanding under the surface after each coat, so that the canvas can be smooth and ready Easy to follow takes you step by step with instructions. By the end of the course, you'll have a canvas ready to paint. Interested in trying out or working to refine your acrylic painting skills? On his YouTube channel, artist Will Kemp writes and creates his videos on classical painting techniques, with a concentration on the use of acrylic paint. Whether you're just starting out or keeping a more ambitious project in mind, Will's video medium will showcase different strategies. Start with simple foundational building blocks, including properly cleaning your acrylic paintbrush, choosing your acrylic paintbrush, applying acrylic colored base and coloring mixing basics. The goal of the class is simple-to teach you how watercolor colors work with water and how to use it effectively. Blakemore's class will run through understanding you the principle of a color wash, how the same color can shape and create shading, how you can create highlights and shadows with watercolors, and how to paint your paint properly.
