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According to Patti Richards Updated June 29, 2018 Family physicians and general practitioners have similar educational and residency requirements, and offer some of the same medical services. Family physicians are certified by the American Family Medicine Board, which requires re-certification every six years through examination. Family doctors must also continue their training for at least 150 hours every three years. General practitioners are certified by the American General Practitioner Council with one of two methods. The primary standard path requires the completion of a general practice training program from the American College of General Medicine.
