LISTED PLACES OF WORSHIP GRANT SCHEME

St Aloysius is a Grade II listed building. Over the years there have been various grants that were reserved specifically for grade-listed buildings. Very sadly, the UK-wide Listed Places of Worship Grant Scheme has closed and the replacement fund applies only in England. For many parishes and dioceses in Scotland, this means essential repairs and improvement projects for listed church buildings will become more expensive, placing further pressure on already stretched budgets. We have been asked by the Bishops Conference to write to our MSPs asking for clarity on support in Scotland and to back a practical Scottish funding route. This is obviously something that has serious implications for the future fundraising for St Aloysius, Church for future projects, so I would ask that you be as supportive as possible in this.
