CIRCULAR NO.25/2022

RE: REVISED VISA REGIME

This circular supersedes any other visa circulars issued prior to it.

1.0 THE MEANING OF VISA

A visa is a tool which provides for preliminary examination of foreign nationals in terms of their suitability to enter the country. It is an endorsement in a valid passport of a foreigner, granting such person authority to enter Zambia within a specific period upon examination by an Immigration Officer at a port of entry.

2.0 TYPES OF VISAS

The Department issues the following types of Visas:

- **2.1** Single Entry Visa A Single Entry Visa allows the traveller to enter Zambia only once during the validity of the visa. The fee is **US \$25**;
- **2.2 Double Entry Visa** A Double Entry Visa allows the traveller to enter Zambia twice during the validity of the visa. The fee is **US \$40**; and
- **2.3** Multiple Entry Visa A Multiple Entry Visa allows the traveller to enter Zambia multiple times during the validity of the visa. The fee is **US \$75**. Multiple Entry Visas shall only be issued by Headquarters through the e-visa facility.

Note: Single, Double and Multiple visas shall be valid for ninety (90) days from the date of first issuance.

Transit Visa— Transit visas are issued to nationals who require visas to enter Zambia and are transiting through the Country using land transport, and shall be valid for a maximum period of seven (07) days. The fee is **US \$25**;

2.4 Day Tripper Visa- A Day tripper visa is issued at a port of entry to a tourist who visits Zambia for a period of less than 24 hours and makes exit through the same port. The facility will also apply to tourists visiting Zambia and wish to visit a neighbouring country and re-enter within 24 hours. The fee is **US \$10**.

Note: The Day Tripper shall only apply at Victoria Falls and Kazungula Border Controls.

3.0 VISITORS AND TOURISTS

All ordinary Visitors and Tourists are entitled to a free ninety (90) days visit in any period of twelve (12) months from the day of first entry into Zambia while business Visitors are entitled to a free thirty (30) days visit in any period of twelve (12) months.

4.0 VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN NATIONALS

Foreign nationals wishing to enter the country fall within one of the three (3) distinct categories:

- Nationals who do not require visas in order to enter Zambia;
- Nationals requiring visas on arrival or Missions Abroad; and
- Nationals required to apply for visas prior their travel to Zambia.

Note: All persons who ordinarily require Visas to come to Zambia are eligible to apply for an e-Visa.

4.1 NATIONALS WHO DO NOT REQUIRE VISAS TO ENTER ZAMBIA

4.3 NATIONALS REQUIRING VISAS PRIOR TO TRAVEL

Zambian entry visas for nationals whose countries fall under this category require advance clearance by the Zambian Authorities. Applicants must apply for the visa through the Director General of Immigration prior to their arrivalinto Zambia. The applicant must receive a letter of approval prior to his/her travel and present it to an Immigration Officer at a port of entry and pay the prescribed fee for thevisa.

5.0 EXCEPTIONAL CASES

5.1 DIPLOMATS ACCREDITED TO ZAMBIA

All Diplomats accredited to Zambia coming on official or private business should be issued with Gratis Visas at Zambian Missions Abroad or Port of Entry. This includes those Diplomats coming to do business with their respective Embassies/High Commissions.

5.2 DIPLOMATS NOT ACCREDITED TO ZAMBIA

All Diplomats not accredited to Zambia coming on official business should be issued with Gratis Visas at Zambian Missions Abroad or Port of Entry. Diplomats not accredited to Zambia coming on private business should obtain Visa in the normal way and pay the applicable visa fee.

5.3 STAFF OF INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS ACCREDITED TO ZAMBIA/AFRICAN REGIONAL GROUPINGS/AFRICAN UNION

- 5.3.1 Gratis Visas should be obtained at Zambian Missions Abroad or at Port of Entry on presentation of letters of accreditation. Persons belonging to International Organizations not accredited to Zambia can obtain visas at Missions Abroad or Ports of Entry on presentation of official or diplomatic passports, in which case the Visa fee shall apply.
- 5.3.2 Persons coming under the umbrella of an African Regional Grouping should be issued a Gratis Visa either at Missions Abroad or port of Entry upon presentation of an official passport and an official letter from that Organization.

5.4 PERSONS COMING TO ZAMBIA ON CONFIRMED GOVERNMNET BUSINESS

Persons holding ordinary passports but coming on Official Government Business should be issued a Gratis Visa either at Missions Abroad or port of Entry upon presentation of official letter from the Government Department/Ministry/Agency.
