Cause and effect help No. 5 - LET SOMEONE/SOMETHING DO SOMETHING This means that you allow (allow, give permission for something) to do something or you allow something to happen. Examples: LET SOMEONE/SOMETHING DO SOMETHING It allowed children not to become until midnight. I let the chicken burn in the oven. Why did he let it happen? Let me go! Cause and effect help No. 6 - HELP SOMEONE (to) DO SOMETHING This means that you are helping (and helping) someone (to) do something. This structure is most commonly used without k. Someone is doing something for us We use there is an object and a past involved when we want to talk about something that someone is doing for us, usually because we pay them, or because we convince or ask them to do it. Compare: We clean the house every Friday. Every Friday we clean the house. (Someone else cleans it for us) The verb is not a verb in this design. We should use made or made for negative suggestions and questions when there is no auxiliary verb. We don't usually have a painted house, we do it ourselves. (NOT: We don't have a painted house) Have you painted your house? It looks great. (NOT: Had you had your house painted?) We can use something to do in any tense verb. I'm going to get my hair cut tomorrow. She's renovating her house. My car changed the oil. She had her hair cut yesterday. Negative experience We can also use something to do with passive meaning when something bad happens to us. His wallet was stolen in Piccadilly. (His wallet was stolen) Fire their home. Get something done in unofficial English, we can use to get the object and past participle with the same how to do something. I need to check my eyes. They rebuilt their home after the earthquake. She got her feet burned in the fire. (negative experience) Have someone do something We can use building to eat a person and an infinitive with the same meaning as doing something, but in this case we mention the person who is doing something for us. Architect to redesign the first floor. Suzanne stole all the trees. Get someone to do something We can also use the construction to get someone infinitive to talk about someone doing something for us because we pay them, or because we asked or convinced them to do it. However, forcing someone to do something often implies the idea that you have convinced someone to do something. I have a mechanic to look at the car.
