The main project of the NGITI foundation for this year was the ICT classroom and its facilities. Around February 2020 BCS 3 Received 27 sets of computers and educational materials for the learners. It was all set for the upcoming school year, but because of COVID, everything was put on hold, and the learning modalities shifted to modular.

For the last 5 years, we've been helping a total of more than 5000 children, particularly in Central School 3, and for the past year children in three other schools.

I have seen the impact of the projects on the children and the community in Bogo. This year, despite the pandemic, we built 2 classrooms in Nailon School and provided modules for 4500 children in 4 different schools.

It's been 5 years that Ngiti got created with the aim to improve the quality of basic education and the learning environment for children in public schools in Bogo city, Philippines.

2020 has been Ngiti's most successful year so far. We were able to make a difference in 4 schools, Bogo central Schools (BCS) 1,2 and 3 and Nailon School.

This has been a major step for our association because till now we were only helping BCS₃.

Our main project and most challenging has been the construction of two classrooms in Nailon School, that will enable children of kindergarden to have more space to learn in a new environment.

The classes will be used from the new school year in April.

The pandemic made Ngiti think of new ways to help the completely changing education system the teachers and children had to face.

With classes in person cancelled in the whole country, millions of children had no more education. Online classes are near to impossible with families having no access to the internet and no computers. Ngiti was determined to give a chance to these children to continue learning. In collaboration with the government, we provided children with weekly modules.

End of January, 23 computers with offline educational programs got delivered to Bogo central School 3.

The children were unable to use them yet but they were used by the teachers to prepare the modules b.

The modules were printed and distributed to the children so they could learn from home.

This enabled 5000 children from the 4 schools in Bogo to continue learning.

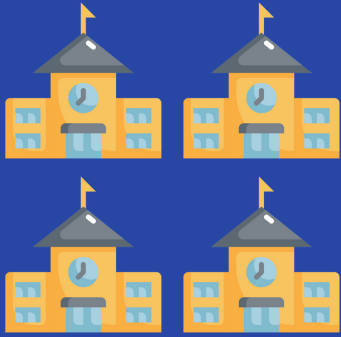

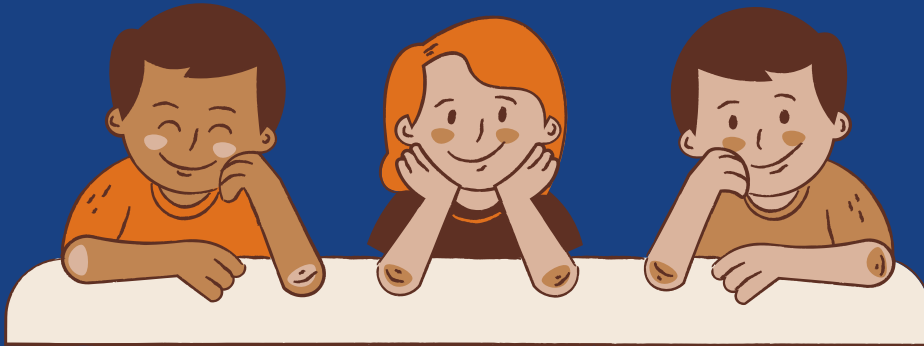

Financial Report of 2020

Weekly Modules printing and distribution for 4 schools:

1370 euros : 3 printers, bond paper, ink, plastic envelopes and pencils.

3000 euros to be sent in January to print more modules for the rest of the year.

Construction of the 2 kindergarten classes in Nailon School.

Details of the amount for this project:

5200 euros: Labor and wages between July 4, 2020 and December 20, 2020

7500 euros: Materials for the construction.

2500 euros more will be used in January 2021 to buy the furniture for the two classes: chairs, tables, fans, black board.
