CAN YOU SEE IF I'M A BEE?

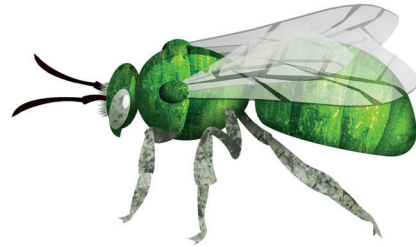
Sometimes insects like to disguise themselves to mimic bees so that predators don't want to eat them.

PLANT A WILD FLOWER GARDEN

Global bee habitats are in a worrying decline! But you can help by planting a wild flower area in your garden. Wild flowers are easy to grow and take very little care, but provide a vital habitat to help bees thrive.

BUILD A BEE HOTEL

MAKE A BEE BATH
