Facts sheet



Meaning

Racial Equality as a socialization message emphasizes that all races are equal and should live together peacefully. These may not always include discussing racial *inequality* in society.

Examples

- "You are just as good/smart/pretty as the white kids."
- "Everyone deserves equal treatment."
- "We should celebrate our differences and know that we all have unique strengths."

Benefits

This type of message forms a belief that *everyone* deserves love and respect, regardless of their race. This may help youth understand they have self-worth, even despite the discrimination they may face.
