



The hall buzzed with excitement as our talented young artists showcased their creativity, energy and passion for the art.






Celebrating Singapore's 60th Birthday



Harp seals, sometimes called *Saddleback seals*, referring to the saddlelike mark on the back and sides of the adults.

There are **6 species** of **ice seals** localising the surface bays of the Northern hemisphere of Greenland, Svalbard and Northern Norway.

The seal referenced on this Deco Art closely resembles the **Harp seal**,
