**MINUTES:**

Motion by Bill Thomas, seconded by Jeri Brayman to approve the January meeting minutes, all in favor, motion carried.

**FLOORTIME:**

- Truck #4 was towed to a frame shop for repair
- Loader was damaged when a huge frozen chunk of sand fell into the front of the cab, it broke out the 2 of 3 piece windshields, bent the front cowl into the dash, bent the handrail, running board, light bracket and broke 2 lights. Still waiting on parts, the cost of parts this far is at about \$800.00. We are doing the work ourselves as the cost is less than the insurance deductible and we can't be without a loader. The loader is still in service but the heater cannot keep up without the windshield.


