MINUTES:

Motion by Steve Roff, seconded by Bill Thomas to approve the April meeting minutes, all in favor, motion carried.

FLOORTIME:

1. Steve Tiska still would like to see a speed limit sign on Pine Hill Rd. Betty again told Steve that the if the board would like to make a motion then we will take a vote on it, at this time the board does not want to do this. We cannot put signs on all the roads; we just do not have the funds to do this. The highway crew is still working on the ditches on Pine Hill. If Steve would like to, he can start a petition.
2. Angela Ellis updated us on the playground. She spoke with the school and they have agreed to let the kids in Masonville use the playground at the old elementary school from the hours of After 5 PM and all day on weekends. They will be doing the following repairs:
 - New backboard
 - Repair blacktop
 - New Rims

- Move the picnic tables
- Possibly next year the Sidney School is updating their playground equipment, and would put the old equipment at our school, they would require the help of the highway crew.

They have also agreed that we can have raised bed for a community garden. Betty says the town will look into adding a rider to the insurance policy.

Angela has created a Facebook post for the playground and activities. We look to adding more activities As we can.

Angela has many great ideas for this area and some walking trails as well.

The town Board Thanked Angela for all of her work and energy on this project.

CORRESPONDENCE:

- Received a check from the Town Clerk for money collected in March of \$325.00.
- Received a check from the court for \$2,765.00.

- Jeri has a quote from Brian Currie of \$700 to do the following:
 - Remove 2 trees
 - Limb the hill
 - Trim pine trees

Approval from the board not to exceed \$1,000. To get it all trimmed up.

- Betty would like to get rid of the Go Daddy web and hire VECC Videography to create and maintain a web site for us, this is the same vendor that is used by many of the towns in Delaware County, the proposal is attached.
- We would like to hold the Memorial Day Parade this year. Craig is going to supply us with traffic control. The parade would begin at Noon.
