Bus Transportation

Transportation is provided in modern, luxury touring buses. Dedicated supervision is present on all non-adult buses.

Departure points in Munich:

Hackerbrücke – 06:20

Solln (Herterichstraße / Drygalski Allee) – 06:20

Buses then proceed to the **MIS parking lot**, where the final pickup is at **07:00 sharp**.

Students and adults travel in separate buses to ensure comfort and social time with peers. MIS teachers, interns, or trainers supervise student buses, providing care and ensuring a fun, safe environment.

In the rare case of poor snow conditions, a replacement date will be scheduled on **March 13th**.

Instruction

Full-day instruction (09:00 – 15:00) is provided in **English**, for all ages and ability levels. Instruction is divided into the following groups:

Junior School (ages 5–10)

Middle School (ages 11–13)

Senior School (ages 14–18)

Adult

We employ approximately 30 experienced instructors to ensure every participant receives personalized attention and is placed in the appropriate group. Instructors meet participants at the bus upon arrival at the venue, and remain responsible for their group throughout the day.

Group sizes: 5–9 participants

Supervision is provided at all times in restaurants, on the slopes, and on the buses. Lessons conclude at 15:00, with buses departing promptly at 15:45.

Note for Beginners:

Consistent attendance is essential. Missing sessions may require private lessons (at the participant's expense) to keep up with the group.

Free Skiing

Adults may choose to join an instructional group or ski independently. All students under 18 are required to participate in group instruction.

Insurance

While all instructors are covered by liability insurance, participants must have their own third-party liability coverage. We recommend the DSV (Deutscher Skiverband) Family Policy, which also covers theft and damage. This can be purchased online or at most sport retailers. Please confirm your individual insurance coverage before participating.

Ski Passes

Ski passes are **not included** in the registration fee and must be purchased each Saturday. We collect passes in advance and distribute them on the bus. For those traveling by car, we offer convenient pickup options.

Estimated Prices (per day):

Children: €32

Youth (16–18): €50

Adults: €60

Final ski pass prices can be subject to changes and will be communicated in the detailed information letter during the **Christmas Vacation**.

Meals

Participants may either bring a **packed lunch** or purchase a **hot meal at a mountain restaurant**. Lunch breaks are one hour and supervised by instructors.

Typical restaurant meal prices range from **18€ -20€**.
