

Heat Exhaustion The more a dog runs, exercises, and plays in the summer, the closer she is to

getting heat stroke. If you notice her drinking too, if her eyes are glazed and her body temperature above normal, in addition to gasping and restlessness, then it's a safe bet she has warm exhaustion. Heat exhaustion works within 15 minutes. She will mortgage strongly and quickly (the more heat, the heavier the gasping,) dehydration will cause kidney damage, and the brain will swell, causing seizures. The body will begin to suffer from the lack of oxygen, eventually shutting down completely. The only alternative to this is to soak in more oxygen, or pants like crazy. As with heat exhaustion, restlessness is not even a problem. If you have an older dog, or you suspect your dog may have heart problems, get her to the vet immediately, if not sooner. 7. Anemia anemia is seriously low red blood cells. Red blood cells carry oxygen throughout the body in the bloodstream. If the body is starved of oxygen, it starts to shut down. The gums will look pink or white, the dog will act confused, will not eat, can not or will not exercise, she will lie around in a weakened state and she will pants. As with heart disease or heart attack, she won't be able to get oxygen into her body unless she pants love their dogs and plan endless treats and special things for them. Cushing's disease Cushing's disease is when the dog's adrenal glands produce more of the hormone cortisol. This is the fight or flight hormone and is released in small amounts in a dog's system for the relief of stress. When too much is released, toxicity enters your dog's body along with glucose from the liver. That sounds like a good thing, but the other effects of this release are not: blood sugar rises, causing thinning of skin and hair. Blood pressure increases, causing loss of muscle and bone mass. Burning glucose means the dog is hungry. If you notice your dog with an unnatural thirst that will lead to unnatural urination, weight gain, and excessive gasping and restlessness, then she has checked out the vet. Cushing's Disease is often missed by doctors because the symptoms are similar to a dozen other medical problems. 10. Respiratory diseases can plague your dog. If she is a pug, Boston terrier, or bulldog, then she will have another reason to pawn excessively and be restless. It will be because that's what her race does.
