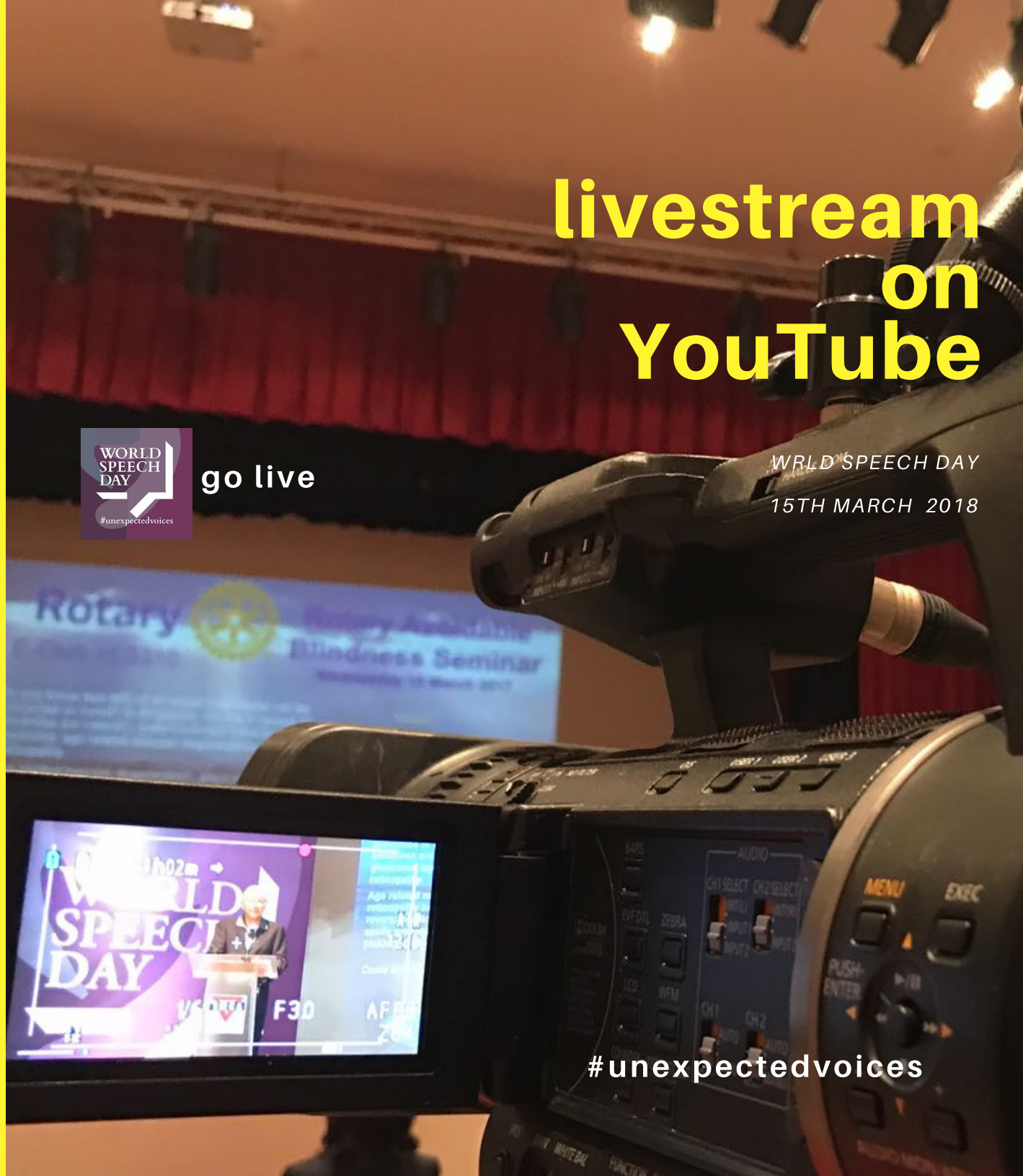

Livestreaming on YouTube is simple and very versatile. You can share your event with the world live on 15th March, WSD 2018, and you can then also make it available to viewers afterwards via YouTube, not to mention other social media channels like Facebook. You can either livestream from a camera connected to your desktop or very simply from your mobile phone. In fact livestreaming from your mobile is so easy it only requires a few moments and for many event organisers it's the simplest and most obvious way to livestream. You need to open a YouTube account and create a channel. Then you need to download the YouTube app to your phone. After that, it's incredibly versatile.
