Exhibition: Art, Conflict and Remembering – The Murals of the Bogside Artists

St Albans Cathedral, 22 September – 9 October

Many will remember this powerful exhibition, curated by Adrienne Chaplin, from three years ago when it was shown at St Paul's to mark the 50th anniversary of Bloody Sunday (30 January 1972). This year, it is hosted in the magnificent setting of St Albans Cathedral, displayed beneath the splendid Rose Window in the North Transept.

The exhibition opened last Monday with Tom Kelly—one of the three Bogside muralists from Derry, Northern Ireland, and a longstanding friend of St Paul's congregation.
