Tupper Saussy\) Rulers of Evil Preface THE ONLY PEOPLE in the world, it seems, who believe in the conspiracy theory of history are those of us who studied it. While Franklin D. Roosevelt might have exaggerated when he said: Nothing happens in politics by accident; if it happens, it was planned that way, Carroll Quigley - Bill Clinton's favorite professor at Georgetown University - bravely admitted in his Tragedy & Hope \( 1 9 6 6 \) that \(a\) the multitudes were already under the control of a small but powerful group bent to world domination and \(b\) Quigley himself was part of that group. Internet conspiracy sites strive to identify conspiratorial factions. We get pieces here and pieces there. The world is run by Freemasons, some say. Others say Skull & Bones, and a loose confederation of secret societies. C I A gets many votes, along with Mossad \(although I suspect these factions are only tools\) and, of course, the British. One of the main forerunners is the International Banking Cartel. When Victor Marsden published The Protocols of the Elders of Zion in 19-0 6, which claimed to be a Jewish plan to take control of the world, Jewish writers denied responsibility, accusing a Catholic plot of defaming Jews. Which way was Marsden? You can get so deep into the conspiracies that the suspects begin to erase each other. It can get frustrating. I'm happy to report that F. Tupper Saussy came to our emotional rescue. During his ten years as a Justice Department fugitive \(convicted of a crime that cannot be found in law books\), Saussy investigated the powers they were. This was an investigation of the caliber of which, as far as I know, has never been undertaken before. The result of his extraordinary legwork is Rulers of Evil, a powerful book that in less loving hands may have been angry and judgmental. Saussy's thesis: There really is a small group that runs the world, but we can't call it conspiracy because it identifies with signs, motets and monuments. Signs, motets and monuments? you ask. If I'm breaking the rules here, well, this is a book that breaks the rules. Example. During last spring's Bookexpo in Los Angeles, I kindly introduced my client, Tupper Saussy, to one of New York's most unhooked editorial executives. While Tupper summed up rulers of evil articulately for him, I personally witnessed the front of this inept executive developing a contraction. I really saw him swallow it. With my own ears I heard him say, This is a little too extreme for us. The contraction developed as Tupper said the Roman Catholic Church really leads the world, including the U.S. government, and this is openly stated in monuments, emblems, and insignia, as well as official documents... When Tupper quietly reached his payoff - And that's good, because he's divinely ordered - the manager was staring into space. All right, Rulers of Evil is extreme. \(Does that scare you?\) It was researched and written during a decade of flight that probably saved the author's life from the vindictive federal authorities. I wanted to represent this book from the moment I read the first draft in 19 9 3, completely unaware that its author could claim the classic Miracle On Main Street as his own. \(Tupper Saussy's identity was not revealed to me until his capture in 1997. It can keep a secret.\) Like no book I've seen in my thirty years as a literary agent, Rulers of Evil explains who really is who in world power, hooks them up like evil \(about evil like the rest of us, more or less\), and then explains how spiritual wickedness in high places works for the ultimate good of humanity. It's the book about conspiracies that doesn't claim to throw away bums. Rulers of Evil is almost a self-help product. The useful knowledge he imparts reveals the structure of the world as it really is. Once we can see, our choices increase, our paths widen and our lives improve. PRESIDENT HARRY S. TRUMAN on FRESHMAN ORIENTATION DAY at the University of the South in Sewanee, Tennessee, sat across the table at my faculty counselor. He was professor of botany named Edmund Berkeley. Dr. Berkeley studied the card of my manila file folder as if they were some rare species of leaves. Suddenly his eyes sprang into his face. Giddy said I was, I swallowed and tried to smile. 'Saussy, he thought calmly. Good Huguenot name. I was puzzled by the word. Huguenot? 'Saussy' is a name French, lectured. Sewanee is a Protestant university. Your people must have been Huguenots. I silently forgave my father for never saying to me that our name was French and that our ancestors could have been something called Huguenots. What exactly are Huguenots? I asked. French Protestants, declared my counselor. Massacred by soldiers ordered by Catherine of Medici in league with the Jesuits. The survivors were exiled. Some settled in England, others in Prussia. Some have come to America, as your people obviously did. Jesuits. That was a familiar word. In Tampa, my hometown, there was a high school named Jesuit. The High Jesuit was highly esteemed academically and athletically. I was aware of a link between the Jesuits and the Roman Catholic Church, but little else. What are Jesuits? I asked. Oh, the Jesuits are members of the Society of Jesus, he replied. Excellent men. Intellectual. They work exclusively for the Pope, they take the oath to him and only to him. There's someone calling them the Pope's private militia. Some kind of swordless army. Controversial. In the past, they've got into trouble meddling with civilian governments, trying to bring them under the pope's rule, you know, but in this century they've been tame considerably. They're wonderful educators. That night I called my father, who responded to Dr. Berkeley's suprosis. Yes, our people were Huguenots. They arrived at savannah harbor in the second of the 18th century, after a stopover of several generations in Scotland. They had indeed been exhausted beloved country, in the same way that the Jews were exhausted by Germany. The Nazis chased the Jews, the Jesuits chased us. An h, but it was a long time ago, my father said, and I agree. Forgiveness is a great virtue, and it is better to let the past be past. So I forgot about huguenots and Jesuits and immersed myself in my university career, in my future, in my life. I never had the opportunity to think about my conversation with Edmund Berkeley until about thirty years later, in August 1984, during a brief but eloquent meeting with an assistant U.S. attorney named John MacCoon. We were a short walk away in the marble hallway outside a federal courtroom in Chattanooga, waiting for the call to the morning session. I was on the docket,](#)

scheduled to be charged with intentionally omitting to file tax returns for years 1 9 7 7, 1 9 7 8 and 1 9 7 9 . I had no doubt that the charges would be dropped. The statute that I would have to apply to the people required to submit returns. Yet I had a letter signed by the District Director of the IRS stating that a diligent search for IRS files had not revealed any tax obligations in my name for those years. Persons who have no tax liability are not required to make statements. Why was I there? The booming voice of a lawyer friend broke my concentration. Tupper, he said, driving me to John MacCoon, did you meet with your d.A.? He presented us jovially and then rushed into a huddle of other stakeholders. MacCoon and I shook hands. John, I asked, feeling the need to have a chat, are you from Chattanooga? No, he replied, I came from Washington. Something inside told me to press. So you're originally from D.C.? No, I was originally from New Orleans. I have a lot of cousins in New Orleans, I teleported. It seemed to get a little edgy. Well, the name Saussy is not unknown there, he said. One of my favorite cousins lives in New Orleans, I said, and he called my cousin. Is that your cousin? Why, he and I were sorted together. Ordered? I asked. My cousin is a Jesuit priest. Are you a Jesuit? Yes, said my d.A., now visibly agitated. You know, I might have to reuse myself. I have a better idea, drop the charges. Oh no, I couldn't do that. The dialogue ended suddenly with the holoday of a bailiff announcing that the court was now in session. So John MacCoon was a Jesuit! The media, snooted from his offices, had already branded me a fiscal protester. What was going on? Were the Jesuits chasing the Protestants again? In fact, I hadn't protested against taxes at all. I discovered some truths about tax and monetary laws and I dared to endure them. As with the Huguenots and the truths they had discovered authorities were offended. Wasn't it interesting that both of us - me and my ancestors - were branded antisocial, repulsive, as people who disturb good order by dared to protest? Was it religious persecution? Was my position on truth somehow so offensive that the Pope had sent one of his swordless warriors to me as I took office? Then there was the date. The charges against me were filed on 3 July. This is the feast of Saint Ignatius of Loyola, the founding father of the Society of Jesus. According to the dogma of the Roman Liturgical Calendar, every cause begun on the feast day of a saint is particularly worthy of the saint's attention. A bizarre series of stealth proceedings occurred over the next eleven months. Discharge evidence has been ignored or suppressed. There were improprieties of the prosecutor, which the court excused. When I tried to avoid the consequences of improprieties, I was punished. Few precedents for such judicial steam rolling were found outside the annals of the Roman Inquisition, which I learned to be administered from 15 4 2 by the Jesuits. What was this: the American Inquisition? Meanwhile, the IRS, John MacCoon and the media continued to label me a tax protester. Sometimes they would slip and call me a tax evader, even though I had never been charged with the much more serious crime of tax evasion. In the final analysis, a jury acquitted me of not voluntarily submitting tax returns for 1 9 7 8 and 1 9 7 9 . But for 1 9 7 7 they found will, and the higher courts upheld their verdict. It was just a crime. The last defendant in my district to be convicted of the same count was sentenced to six weeks. But the court sentenced me to a whole year, the maximum allowed by the statute. This is due to what the prosecutor called my unrepentant. Some say I should have cried crocodile tears and I promised to fix my streets. But this would be gameplay. How can you regret not being able to voluntarily do something that has never been requested in the first place? When I soberly examined the prosecutor's long list of nonsense, I decided I would be punished for something that was nowhere near related to the will to file tax returns. I was punished for mobilising what turned out to be the only constitutional issue that no court in the United States will fully entertain – the issue of money. In the late 1970s, I discovered that constitutional government was violating every American's right to an economy free from fluctuating monetary values. I wrote a book The Miracle On Main Street: Yourself and America from Financial Ruin ( 1 9 8 0 ), in which I compared American money as imposed by the Constitution, gold and silver money, with American money currently in use - banknotes, computer entries and basic metal tokens. Not only was the money in use constitutional money, but it was introduced without a constitutional amendment. Because our values were denominated in lawless money units, we had become a lawless nation. The quality of life follows the quality of money. I have urged citizens to take the initiative to push government officials to restore the kind of monetary system established by the Constitution. The final payoff would be a healthy society. Main Street activism would have done a miracle. MOMS started very quickly. Activists began asserting economic rights in many creative ways. To assist and document their work, I launched The Main Street Journal. Published more or less monthly, the MSJ has detailed the interesting, sometimes frightening consequences of economic rights activism. On 19 July 84, my book and diary had expanded into a growing bibliography of historical and legal materials relating to the monetary question. I spoke all over the country and held well-attended seminars in Tennessee. We had history on our side. The framers of the Constitution unanimously rejected the kind of monetary system that was destroying modern America, and they voted unanimously in favor of the system we supported. We had the law on our side. The Supreme Court had never ruled that the lawless U.S. monetary system was constitutional. What we didn't have on our side was that the entity had more to gain from lawless money - governing bodies. We were deeply offending their aspect of legitimacy. As a Tennessee village lawyer said, in returning Miracle On Main Street to the friend who lent it to him, This book won't have Saussy killed, but they'll find a humane way to silence him. There was a two-year interval between my trial and the Supreme Court's decision on it. Halfway through that interval, I got a postcard from Tennessee's most famous prisoner, James Earl Ray. Ray, dr. Martin Luther King's self-convicted killer, wanted me to help him write his autobiography. I interviewed personally, examined his manuscript and conducted some of my own research. The evidence convinced me that Mr. Ray did not deserve to be called, in the words of Life Magazine, the most hated man in the world. He had been tortured to plead guilty. Far from punishing for murder, his confinement was the government's way of hiding real murderers, and at the expense of Tennessee taxpayers. I felt that he, like me, was being mischievously used by governing bodies in order to deceive the public. I worked closely with Mr. Ray, publishing his autobiography under the title Tennessee Waltz: The Making of A Prisoner. I have included an epilogue of mine, The Politics of Witchcraft, in which I discussed how the murder of Dr. King did not benefit anyone as much as the economic powers of About a month before Tennessee Waltz came out of the press, I was notified that the U.S. Supreme Court had denied my appeal. Then the district judge ordered me to turn myself in to the federal prison camp in Atlanta on or before April 10, 1987. A friend said, You know, if your previous writings led to tax prosecution, think about what might provoke them, with you in custody... And so, when it came time for me to go through the gates of the prison camp, something got in my way. I can only call it spirit, irresistible spirit. It was the same spirit that directed me to stand on the truth in my writing and in my speaking. It was the same spirit that led me to question John MacCoon at our first meeting in that marble corridor in 1984, the same spirit that moved him to tell me he was a Jesuit. This spirit drove me away from the prison gate and took me into a runaway lifestyle. I felt the overwhelming obligation to love my enemies by studying them in intricate details. I wanted to know the extent of Jesuit involvement in the U.S. government, currently and historically. What I discovered was a vast Roman Catholic substrate for American history, particularly the revolution that produced the constitutional republic. I found that the Jesuits played prominent and under-appreciated roles in moving complacent English new Yorkers to rebel against their motherpat. I discovered facts and motivations that strongly suggested that the events that divided Britain in 17-7 6 were the work of an ingenious Jesuit strategy. This strategy seems to have been designed on its own and supervised by a true founding father few Americans have ever heard of - Lorenzo Ricci (known to British Jesuits as Laurence Richey). In fact, investigating the involvement of the Jesuits in the formation of the United States evolved a number of hitherto little-known names, such as Robert Bellarmine, Joseph Amiot, the Dukes of Norfolk, Daniel Coxe, Sun-Tzu, Lord Bute, Francis Thorpe, Nikolaus von Hontheim and Carrolls, Daniel, Charles and John. In their way, these men were essential to our constitutional origins such as Jefferson, Paine, Adams, Washington, Locke, and George III. My investigation began in 19 8 7. He ran ten years and ranged – with the help of our Lord and many brave friends, to whom this book is dedicated – from the Florida Keys to Puget Sound, from the District of Columbia to Southern California. The growing evidence inexorably changed the way I perceived authority, and my relationship with it. Finally, at the thirteenth minute of the thirteenth hour of the thirteenth day of November, 19 9 7, the journey began with the of the charges against me thirteen years before he reached his destination. I was captured without inexcuse by three U.S. marshals outside my office the canals of Venice, California. A precious person I was ready to deny forever was given to me. For sixteen months, the Bureau of Prisons gave me the opportunity to discuss the fruits of my investigation with smart prisoners in California, Georgia, Tennessee, Oklahoma and Mississippi. Their simple questions, comments, insights and criticism helped further prepare my manuscript for a general audience.
