THURSDAY – OCT. 15TH, 2026 - DEADLINE FOR ALL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS, INCLUDING NONREFUNDABLE \$250.00 ENTRY FEE. For first time contestants, please include a copy of your driver's license. Entry requirements besides the entry fee and a copy of driver's license, includes 5,6,7, & 8. Pages 9 & 10 are OPTIONAL but required if competing for the Mary Frances Hansen Community Service Award.

When you have made the commitment to be added to the 2027 Contestant List, reserve your spot by mailing the following items:

- A Non-refundable entry fee of \$250 REQUIRED - check or money order made payable to Ms. Texas Senior America.
- A Copy of your Driver's License -REQUIRED FOR FIRST TIME CONTESTANTS- *to validate the age requirement (60+) and that you are a Texas Resident.*

SECOND STEPS! – REQUIRED – FORMS - YOU ARE NOT AN OFFICIAL CONTESTANT UNTIL YOUR PAYMENT AND REQUIRED PAGES 5, 6, 7, 8, ALONG WITH THE OPTIONAL PAGES 9 & 10, HAVE BEEN RECEIVED BY DR. SYNTHA. PAGES ARE TO BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN THURSDAY, OCTOBER 15TH, 2026.

When you have been confirmed, continue the *Entry Process* by following the next steps:

1. Go to the website, (www.mstexassenioramerica.org), and click on the “Participate” link. Scroll down and download pages ,5,6,7,8, 9 and 10 and fill out. **Pages 5 & 6** are used by the judges in the judge’s interview. This is their FIRST IMPRESSION of you, so remember how powerful that first impression can be.

Page 7 is the PHILOSOPHY OF LIFE Statement. IT CANNOT BE MORE THAN 35 SPEAKING SECONDS! This will be said on stage during the evening gown competition and will be timed! Judges will score both evening gown and philosophy of Life statement at the same time. If a contestant goes over the 35 seconds, deductions will be taken from her score.

2. **Page 8** is the Talent Presentation. This MUST NOT EXCEED 2 Minutes and 45 Seconds!! Your talent may be traditional or non-traditional, as long as it is confined to the time allotment stated. Each Contestant is expected to have a talent and costume appropriate to

the standards of the MTSA Pageant. The Production Manager, AT HER DISCRETION, may require a change or modification to any talent or costume deemed inappropriate or offensive. 2 THUMB DRIVES are REQUIRED if applicable. It can also be submitted on a CD if other avenues do not work. Stage size 16 X 22, 3 feet up off the ground.

THIRD STEPS!! - OPTIONAL— Your Volunteer Documentation

If you do Volunteer Work and can justify your volunteer hours for the past 12 months, you will want to enter your application for the esteemed *Mary Frances Hansen Community Service Award*. Remember that these volunteer hours are OUTWARD focused for service to others, making their lives personally better. Volunteering is NOT SELF SERVING, for example, Class Act, Dallas Tap Dazzlers, Spectacular Senior Follies. A MTSA Board Committee will select this award which will be announced at the end of the pageant. To enter this portion of the competition, Complete the following:

- a. Download **pages 9 & 10** from the website.
- b. Write each volunteer activity on a separate line and put the number of hours volunteered to the left of each activity.
- c. Put the total number of hours earned at the top right of Page 10. These total listed hours are required!

THESE PAGES CAN ALL BE EMAILED AT NO COST TO YOU AND DON'T CREASE to drsynthawest@yahoo.com. REMEMBER TO SEND ALL PAGES AT THE SAME TIME. IF YOU CHOOSE TO USE THE US POSTAL SERVICE RATHER THAN EMAIL, PUT ALL PAGES IN A LARGE MANILLA ENVELOPE, HAVE ENVELOPE WEIGHED, AND THEN MAIL TO DR. SYNTHA AT THE ADDRESS ON PAGE TWO.
