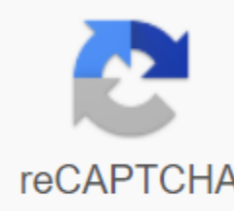

There really is no discussion of different views or an explanation of doctrinal development in the history of the church. It's a strange book. Somehow it was a necessary text back in the day, along with Annes, Ryrie and Chafer. His mixed bag of moderate theology in conservative and dispensational traditions ... but it doesn't really stand out as a great job or even a classic. I'm not sure how he survived so many seals (especially the Eerdmans), other than perhaps Professor Biola demanding it. Not bad. Not good. The best texts are available to understand this brand of theology. An excellent reference to the biblical doctrine of Thyssen follows Princeton theologians in its layout and theology, but is very different from a number of aspects of Calvinist theology.
