The children are all settling in so well. It is great to see some children developing in confidence to ask for things, build friendships, take turns and tolerate each other at preschool. Staff members have had some very mature conversations with children about how they learn and what makes them happy. We can't wait to see you all next week.

Next week our theme will be animals. There will be lots of songs and rhymes, hunting for animals, collaging fish, and learning facts about our favourite animals. We will also be celebrating European languages week by learning to say 'Hello' in our welcome circle in a different language each day.
