Are you aged over 40 and still waiting for your 2nd jab? You can have your 2nd Covid Vaccine after 8 weeks, giving you the strongest protection. If you want to rebook your appointment, you'll first need to cancel your existing appointment at <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/coronavirus-vaccination/> or by calling 119. You can then book your second jab for an earlier time (as long as it's at least 8 weeks after your first jab). Are you aged 21 & over?
