



Instructions for Testing

Important Note:

SeekInClarity® is a monitoring test, is not diagnostic, and does not infer therapeutic choice. **Your "negative" result does not guarantee that the cancer will never progress or relapse.** All results should be interpreted by a clinician.

Who should take this test?

The SeekInClarity® test is indicated for patients who are previously diagnosed with advanced cancer.

SeekInClarity® is intended to detect and quantify how much molecular tumor burden is in the body, to detect response promptly and to help optimize treatment decisions. Regular SeekInClarity® test under physician guidance is recommended for pan-cancer/pan-indication treatment response monitoring.

Understanding your results:

- **Positive:** The test detected possible cancer signals in blood. The result must be confirmed by qualified professionals following clinical standardized procedures. Cancer monitoring or treatment decisions are the responsibility of the treating physician.
- **Negative:** No cancer signal was detected in blood, which does not guarantee that there are no cancer signals in the blood and that it will never be detected.

Important reminders:

- Blood sample collection, transportation, storage, and non-standard processing may impact the performance of SeekInClarity®.
- Because the results of SeekInClarity® can change over time, the SeekInClarity® test needs to be repeated during cancer management as directed by a professional or doctor.
- By showing the increase or decrease in molecular tumor burden (MTB) score between two tests, SeekInClarity® reflects changes in cancer signals and highlights the effectiveness of treatment.
