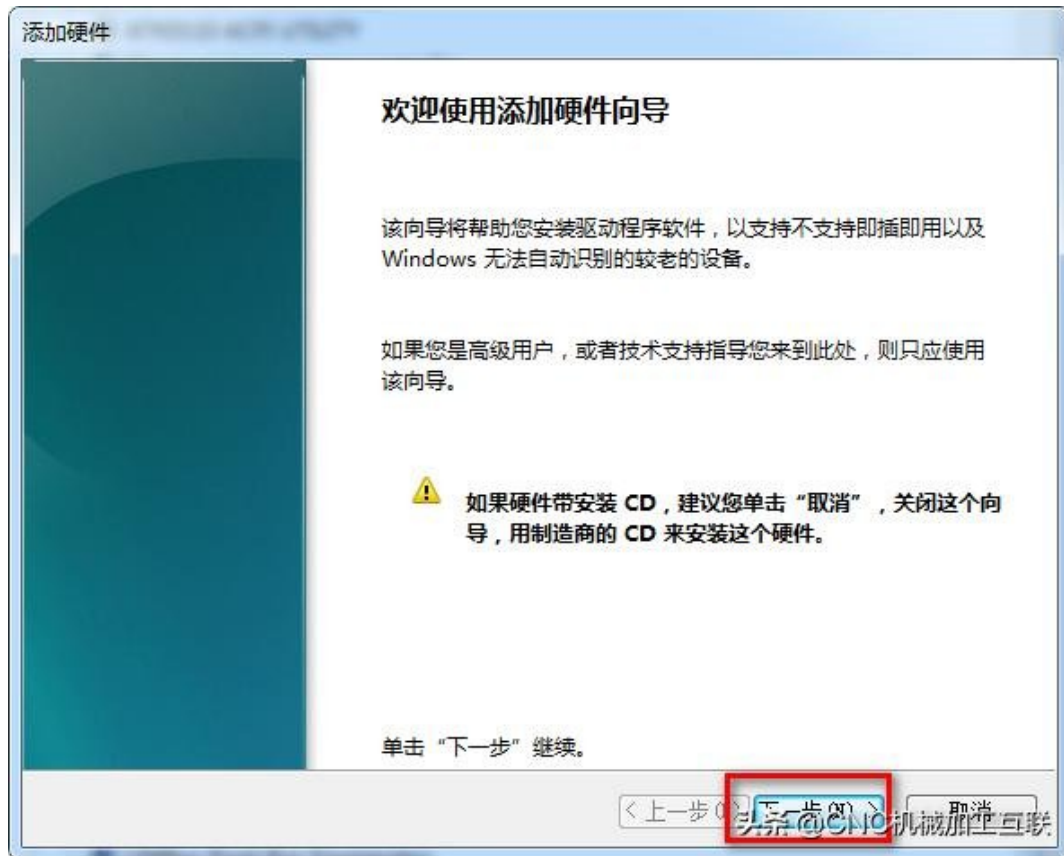

Evaluation of the tumor suppressor gene BRCA1 with the Bethesda assay in sporadic breast cancer in Latin America: incidence, frequency, and potential impact on prognosis. The objective of the study was to assess the incidence and prevalence of germ-line mutations in the BRCA1 gene in patients with breast cancer in Latin America and to estimate the potential impact on prognosis. A cohort of 1,935 breast cancer patients was studied for the presence of mutations in the BRCA1 gene using the four-primer rapid amplification of cDNA ends test (RACE) in the Breast Cancer Linkage Consortium (BCLC) laboratory. The overall incidence of germ-line mutations was 2.8% (64 patients). The BRCA1 mutation carriers were older at diagnosis (56.3 ± 13.4 vs. 50.6 ± 12.5 y; $P = 0.0024$), had earlier age of onset of breast cancer (44.2 ± 12.4 vs. 51.9 ± 10.5 y; $P = 0.0001$), and had significantly higher rates of a positive family history of breast cancer. An analysis of estrogen and progesterone receptors showed no differences in the BRCA1 mutated versus BRCA1 non-mutated group. The mutated cohort had a significantly higher proportion of estrogen receptor-negative tumors and a higher nodal involvement rate at the time of diagnosis. Regarding the prognostic analysis, we observed no differences in disease-free and overall survival in the mutated and non-mutated groups. These data suggest that the prevalence of BRCA1 mutations is lower than previously reported, but it is not negligible in Latin America. The age of onset of breast cancer and the positive family history of breast cancer are important risk factors for germ-line BRCA1 mutations in Latin America.
