The R.E.A.C.T Program

The R.E.A.C.T program is 2 day training program aimed to introduce the fundamental skills required by team members who operate in an austere environment.

Explora can provide one-off training courses for organisations who operate in austere environments, or Explora can provide a licensing agreement and support for 3rd party delivery of this program following the completion of a 4 day train-the-trainer program.

The program has been accredited through the Academy of Extreme Environment Medicine for 6 CPD / Fellowship credits.

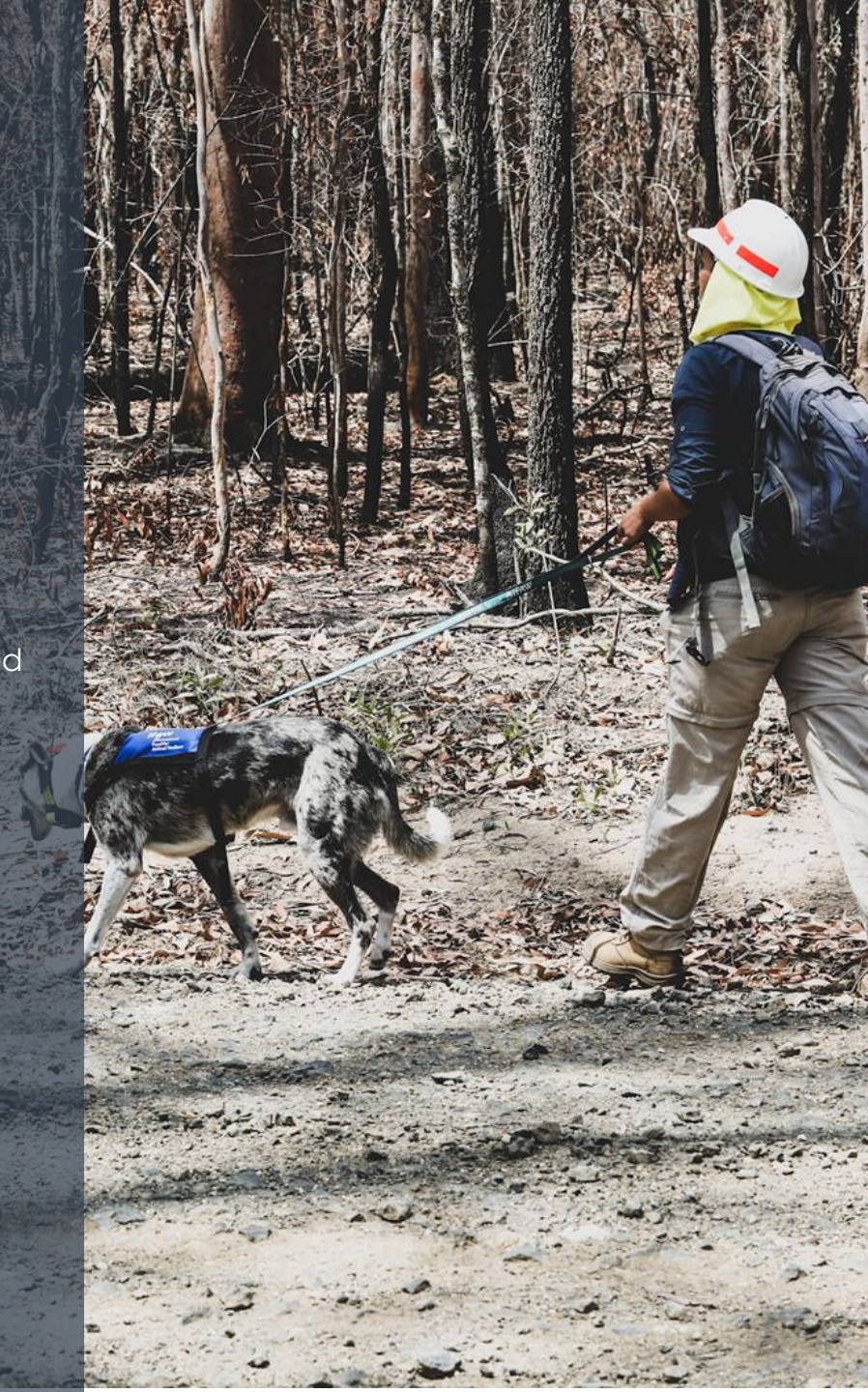

The goal is to maximise the development of practical skills that enable the participant to operate safely in an austere environment

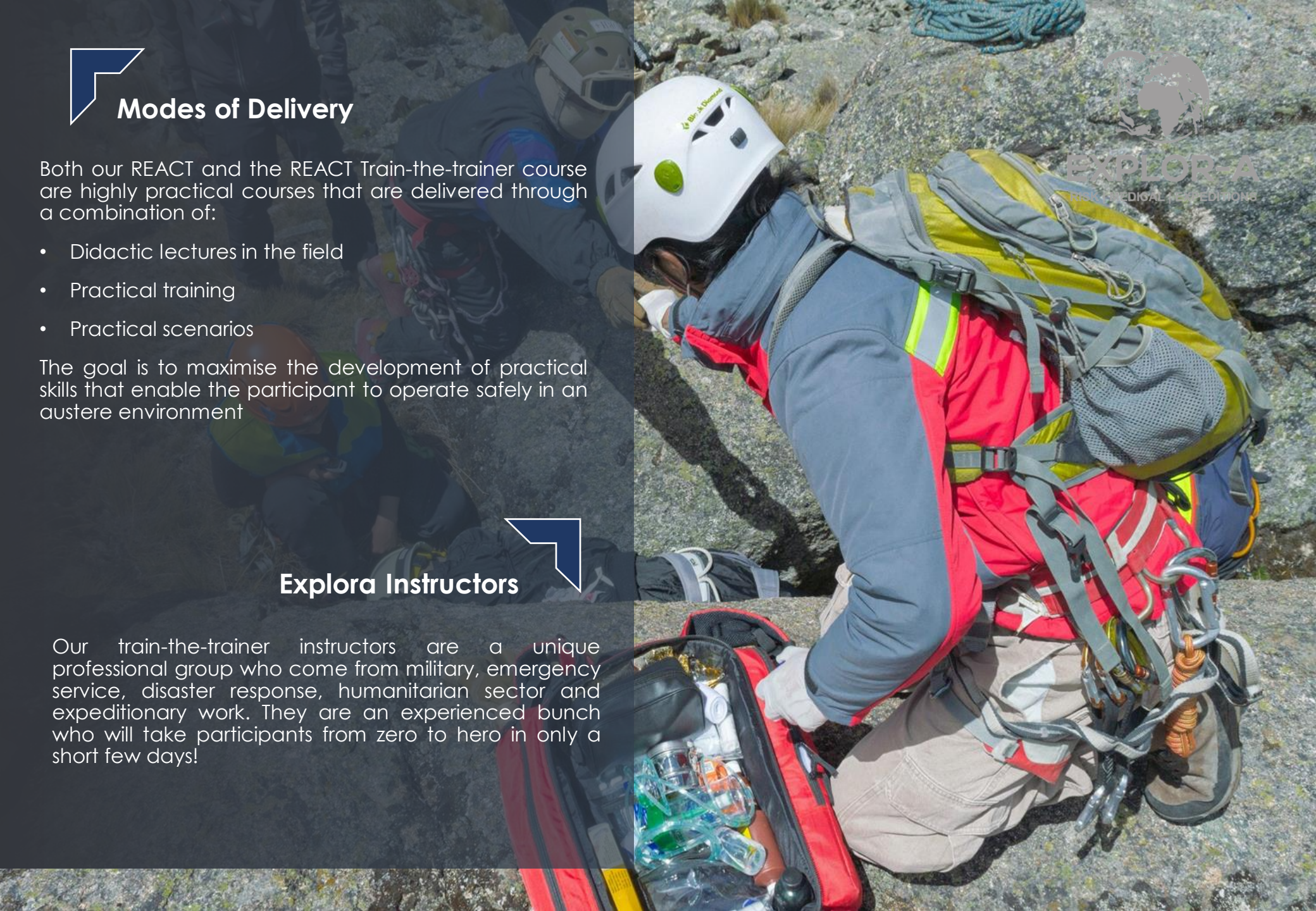


Explora Instructors

Licensing, Delivery & Certification

REACT Train-the-Trainer Course

Explora facilitates a train-the-trainer course for licensees at a flat rate for any location in Australia.

Duration: 4 days

Fee: \$9,450.00 AUD

Participants: 4 – 8

REACT Course

Licensees are approved to run this training at their discretion. Licensees may charge a fee for hosting a REACT course. Explora do not charge fees to the licensee associated with future training.

Certificates and Transcripts can be issued by Explora at the request of either the individual participant, or the licensee as a group. There is a flat rate of \$45.00 per certificate issued by Explora on completion of the training. Licensees are not permitted to issue REACT certificates.

It is a requirement that licensees use the REACT course resources, training plan, and PowerPoints. Licensees can add optional industry-relevant content to their course at their discretion.
