The purpose of this circular is to seek your approval of resolutions to grant a general mandate to the Directors to repurchase the Shares representing up to a maximum of 10% of the aggregate number of issued Shares at the date of passing the resolution, to grant a general

mandate to the Directors to issue new Shares up to a maximum of 20% of the aggregate number of issued Shares at the date of passing of the resolution and to increase the number of Shares which the Directors may issue under their general mandate to issue new Shares by the number of Shares repurchased. Resolutions will also be proposed to re-elect the retiring Directors and to re-appoint the auditors of the Company in accordance with the Articles. These resolutions will be proposed at the Annual General Meeting to be held on 2 June 2015.

2. GENERAL MANDATE TO REPURCHASE OF SHARES

A resolution will be proposed at the Annual General Meeting for the grant of the Repurchase Mandate to the Directors to repurchase, on the Stock Exchange or on any other stock exchange on which the Shares may be listed, the Shares not exceeding 10% of the aggregate number of issued Shares as at the date of passing of the resolution.

Subject to the passing of the proposed resolution granting the Repurchase Mandate to the Directors and on the basis that no Shares will be issued or repurchased by the Company between the Latest Practicable Date and the date of the Annual General Meeting, the Company will be allowed under the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase a maximum of 40,248,400 Shares.

3. GENERAL MANDATE TO ISSUE SHARES

As at the Latest Practicable Date, a total of 402,484,000 Shares were in issue. Brief biographical details of the retiring Directors who are proposed to be re-elected at the Annual General Meeting are set out in Appendix II to this circular.

The following is the explanatory statement which is required to be sent to the Shareholders under the Share Buy Back Rules in connection with the Repurchase Mandate.

1. LISTING RULES

The Listing Rules permit companies with a primary listing on the Stock Exchange to purchase their securities subject to certain restrictions.

The Listing Rules provide that all proposed repurchases of shares by a company with a primary listing on the Stock Exchange must be approved by shareholders in advance by an ordinary resolution in a general meeting, either by way of a general mandate or by a specific approval of a particular transaction and that the shares to be repurchased must be fully paid up.

2. REASONS FOR REPURCHASE

The Directors believe that it is in the best interests of the Company and its Shareholders for the Directors to have a general authority from the Shareholders to enable the Company to repurchase Shares in the market. Such repurchase may, depending on the market conditions and funding arrangement at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value of the Company and/or its earnings per Share and will only be made when the Directors believe that such a repurchase will benefit the Company and the Shareholders.

3. SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 402,484,000 Shares.

Subject to the passing of the Repurchase Mandate, the Company would be allowed to repurchase Shares up to a maximum of 40,248,400 Shares on the basis that no further Shares will be issued or otherwise repurchased and cancelled prior to the date of the forthcoming Annual General Meeting.

4. FUNDING OF REPURCHASES

In repurchasing Shares, the Company may only apply funds legally available for such purpose in accordance with the Articles, the Listing Rules and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands.

It is presently proposed that any purchase of the Shares would be made out of profits of the Company or the proceeds of a fresh issue made for the purpose or out of capital provided that on the day immediately following the date of repurchase the Company is able to pay its debts as they fall due in the ordinary course of business.

Taking into account the current financial position of the Company, the Directors consider the repurchase of Shares in full at any time during the proposed repurchase period may have a material adverse impact on the working capital or gearing position of the Company as compared with the position disclosed in the published audited financial statements as at 31 December 2014, but the Directors do not propose to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such an extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse impact on the working capital or gearing ratio of the Company.

6. TAKEOVERS CODE AND MINIMUM PUBLIC FLOAT

If as a result of a repurchase of Shares, a Shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases, such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purpose of the Takeovers Code. As a result, a Shareholder or a group of Shareholders acting in concert, depending on the level of increase of the Shareholders' interest, may obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, according to the register kept by the Company pursuant to section 336 of the SFO and so far as is known to, or can be ascertained after reasonable enquiry by the Directors, the following persons were directly or indirectly interested in 5% or more of the issued share capital of the Company. Their respective interest as at the Latest Practicable Date is shown under the column “Before repurchase” while their respective interest in the event that the Directors exercise in full the power to repurchase Shares in accordance with the terms of the ordinary resolutions in relation to the Repurchase Mandate to be proposed at the Annual General Meeting (and assuming that the issued share capital of the Company remains unchanged up to the date of the Annual General Meeting) is shown under the column “After repurchase”:

The increase of Huimin’s proportionate interest in the Company as a result of the exercise of the Repurchase Mandate will be treated as an acquisition for the purpose of the Takeovers Code. Accordingly, Huimin or a group of Shareholders acting in concert with it may obtain or consolidate control of the Company and, when exceeding the 2% creeper, become obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code as a result of any such increase.

Save as disclosed herein, the Directors are not aware of any consequences which may arise under the Takeovers Code if the Repurchase Mandate is exercised.

The Directors have no present intention to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such an extent as would trigger the application of the Takeovers Code in the manner described above.

Assuming that there is no issue of Shares between the date of this circular and the date of a repurchase and no disposal by any of the substantial Shareholders of their interests in the Shares, an exercise of the Repurchase Mandate whether in whole or in part will not result in less than 25% of the Shares being held by the public. In any event, the Directors do not intend to repurchase Shares which would result in a public shareholding of less than the minimum percentage of Shares in public hands as prescribed under the Listing Rules.

7. SHARE REPURCHASES BY THE COMPANY

The Company had not purchased any Shares (whether on the Stock Exchange or otherwise) since the Listing Date up to and including the Latest Practicable Date.

8. GENERAL INFORMATION AND UNDERTAKINGS

- (a) None of the Directors nor, to the best of their knowledge having made all reasonable enquiries, any of their close associates (as defined in the Listing Rules), has any present intention to sell any Shares to the Company in the event that the granting of the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.
- (b) The Directors have undertaken to the Stock Exchange that, so far as the same may be applicable, they will exercise the Repurchase Mandate in accordance with the Listing Rules and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands.
- (c) No core connected person (as defined in the Listing Rules) has notified the Company that he has a present intention to sell Shares to the Company, or has undertaken not to do so, in the event that the granting of the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.

The biographical details of the retiring Directors eligible for re-election at the AGM are set out below:

Mr. Zhou Shigang, aged 40, is an executive Director and a director of Hunan Huisheng, being responsible for the overall administration of the Group. Mr. Zhou was appointed as a Director in February 2014. Mr. Zhou is one of the Controlling Shareholders. Mr. Zhou joined the Group as the head of the general administration department of Hunan Huisheng in November 2007 and became its director in January 2009. Prior to joining the Group, Mr. Zhou worked as the head of production at Jinda Concrete from February 2002 to January 2005. Mr. Zhou obtained his diploma in marketing from Hunan University of Commerce* (湖南商學院) in December 1999.

Mr. Zhou has entered into a service contract with the Company for an initial term of three years commencing on 28 February 2014, which is renewable automatically for successive terms of one year after the expiry of the term of appointment, unless terminated by not less than three months' notice in writing served by either party and is subject to retirement by rotation and re-election in accordance with the Articles. Mr. Zhou is entitled to receive HK\$180,000 per annum as director's remuneration which is determined by reference to his duties and responsibilities within the Company, the Company's remuneration policy and the market salary range for the position. Mr. Zhou is also entitled to receive salary of approximately RMB47,000 per annum in relation to his employment in Hunan Huisheng. As at the Latest Practicable Date, Mr. Zhou holds approximately 11.0% equity interest of Jisheng, which is interested in about 20.4% of the entire issued share capital of the Company.

Saved as disclosed above, (i) Mr. Zhou does not have any other relationship with any directors, senior management, substantial or controlling shareholders of the Company; (ii) he does not have any other interest in the shares or underlying shares of the Company within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO; (iii) he does not hold any other directorships in public companies the securities of which are listed on any securities market in Hong Kong or overseas in the last three years; and (iv) he does not hold other positions with the Company and its subsidiaries.

Mr. Zhang Zhizhong, aged 46, was appointed as a non-executive Director in February 2014. Mr. Zhang is one of the Controlling Shareholders and is a director of Jisheng Holdings Limited, which is holding approximately 20.4% of the total issued share capital of the Company. He joined the Group as director of Hunan Huisheng in November 2007 and has also acted as a director of Taoyuan County Huisheng Meat Products Company Limited* (桃源縣惠生肉業有限公司) since its establishment in September 2014. Prior to joining the Group, Mr. Zhang worked at Changde Construction from September 1990 to May 2002, engaging in construction projects management, and acted as the financial manager of Jinda Concrete from April 2003 and was promoted to be the general manager in March 2004, being responsible for its daily operation and management. Mr. Zhang obtained a diploma in legal studies from Hunan Radio & TV University* (湖南廣播電視大學) in January 2008.

Mr. Zhang has entered into a letter of appointment with the Company for a term of two years commencing on 28 February 2014 and is subject to retirement by rotation and re-election in accordance with the Articles. Mr. Zhang is entitled to receive RMB60,000 per annum as director's remuneration which is determined by reference to his duties and responsibilities

within the Company, the Company's remuneration policy and the market salary range for the position. As at the Latest Practicable Date, Mr. Zhang holds approximately 33.0% equity interest of Jisheng, which is interested in about 20.4% of the entire issued share capital of the Company.

Saved as disclosed above, (i) Mr. Zhang does not have any other relationship with any directors, senior management, substantial or controlling shareholders of the Company; (ii) he does not have any other interest in the shares or underlying shares of the Company within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO; (iii) he does not hold any other directorships in public companies the securities of which are listed on any securities market in Hong Kong or overseas in the last three years; and (iv) he does not hold other positions with the Company and its subsidiaries.

Mr. Ma Yiu Ho, Peter, aged 50, was appointed as an independent non-executive Director in February 2014. He is currently the financial controller of Chyau Fwu Properties Limited, a company principally engaged in property development and hospitality. He has been a member of the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants since February 1990 and a fellow member of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (UK) since April 1994. Mr. Ma obtained a master degree of business administration from the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology in November 1995. He is also an associate member of the Hong Kong Institute of Directors. He has over 20 years of experience in the finance and accounting field. Mr. Ma is currently an independent non-executive director of Convoy Financial Services Holdings Limited (stock code: 1019), China Packaging Holdings Development Limited (stock code: 1439) and Sky Forever Supply Chain Management Group Limited (stock code: 8047) since March 2010, December 2013 and July 2014 respectively, all are listed companies of the Stock Exchange.

Mr. Ma has entered into a letter of appointment with the Company for a term of two years commencing on 28 February 2014 and is subject to retirement by rotation and re-election in accordance with the Articles. Mr. Ma is entitled to receive HK\$150,000 per annum as director's remuneration which is determined by reference to his duties and responsibilities within the Company, the Company's remuneration policy and the market salary range for the position. Save for the directors' fees, Mr. Ma is not expected to receive any other remuneration for holding his office as an independent non-executive Director.
