Click here to request an app to add. You can see the most popular apps downloaded through Homebrew Browser here. Note: Open Store channel project to have more up-to-date and up-to-date applications in the Homebrew browser. If you want to use the old Homebrew Browser repository, you can edit settings.xml and change setting_server from 0 to 1. You can also do this in the app settings. Features One Click download / (un) set/update for each homegrown Auto Update app when your Homebrew Browser version is out of date How to install a Create/app folder at the root of your SD card (e.g. E:/apps). Copy homebrew_browser folder into folder/apps on

your SD card. Make sure the little lock switch on your SD card is off. Running through the Homebrew channel. In addition, if you download boot.dol using wilload.exe (including Homebrew Channel), and possibly other similar methods, Homebrew Browser will offer to download and install the latest version of itself on the SD card automatically. Use You can view this guide that shows how to use a homebrew browser. If you use Homebrew Channel then extract homebrew_browser catalog from the archive in the app catalog to the root of your SD card. Running homebrew browser from Homebrew channel and your Wii should be connected to the internet. Uses Wiimote with IR to choose your favorite homegrown app. Green Tick - You have the latest version of that homegrown app installed. Yellow question mark - You might not have the latest version of this home-grown app installed. The list includes app names, image file sizes, download file sizes and whether it is a dol or elf file, as well as the names of any other required files. HBB checks whether the user has the latest image files (stored in apps/homebrew_browser/temp) for all homegrown. If the image is out of date or missing, it uploads the image file. Once in HBB and when choosing a game to install, it loads file and downloads icon.png if necessary from the server. It then removes the lightning file and removes the zip file. When HBB updates the app, it will overwork any existing files that the app app Notes for Homebrew Developers As icons for HBB are selected if there is no icon.png file in homegrown applications, then the icon is included if you can find. Homebrew naming folder app I will stick to folder names used when extracting each homegrown application. The folders with the gaps will be replaced with the underlined. If the files don't enter the folder, the folder name will be created. If your home-grown app has used the folder name to HBB and you've updated the app, the user will notice that there is an update to your app. MAsteroids are an example. The game was developed before HBB. Let's say the game is updated. Since they use the name of the folder, I can just place a new boot.dol/elf on the server, change the file size and when the user downloads HBB he notices that they have an existing MAsteroids setup and then the user can upgrade to the latest version. Homebrew Standards include icon.png and meta.xml file with your homebrew app. Make sure the size of the icon.png file is 128 x 48. Try following the meta.xml standard and test the meta.xml file in HBC. Include the date and version number with your homegrown release, otherwise I will use the timestamp of the boot.dol/elf file and call it v0.1 or v1.0. Put your homegrown app files in a folder and then zip up that folder. Try to continue to use this name folder for homegrown life apps.
