Strawberry Preschool Families,

There are new State Licensing Rules, Signed by Governor Brown, requiring everyone who volunteers or works in the classroom to have the following 3 vaccines:

- 1. MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella)
- 2. Pertussis (Whopping Cough)
- 3. Influenza Vaccine

## Who needs these vaccinations?

- 1. Field trip driver volunteers
- 2. Volunteers in the classroom
- 3. Classroom aids
- 4. Teachers

## Who does not need these vaccinations?

- 1. Parents dropping off or picking up their child from school
- 2. Specialists
- 3. People dropping off food at school (you do need it if you want to cook with the children at school)
- 4. People observing in the classroom
- 5. People attending our social events: Halloween Party, Thanksgiving Feasts, Graduation Ceremony, End of the Year Picnic, Etc.

## The New Rules:

- A person is exempt from the requirements of this section only under any of the following circumstances
  - The person submits a written statement from a licensed physician declaring that because of the person's physical condition or medical circumstances, immunization is not safe.
  - The person submits a written statement by a licensed physician proving that the person has evidence of current immunity to the disease described in subdivision.
  - The person submits a written declaration that he or she has declined the influenza vaccination. This exemption applies only to the influenza vaccine.
  - To prove you are immune to measles, there is a blood test to show you already had the shot or are immune to it. Ask your doctor for more information.

Once you are able to provide proof of the vaccinations, I will keep them at school. You WILL NOT need to re-submit them each year, or when a younger sibling starts.
