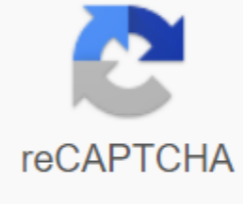

First in every cycle! So the additional steps we have to take in the loop are the open link from the OpenURL column. Get a redirected URL: I found the easiest to do this to use the query module. Reforme the structure of the URL line to be Endpoint URL to download PDF file. We can do this with str.replace . Download the book using wget as planned. Then the generic Python codes will look like this: download_textbooks.pyPostle. You run the Python script with python download_textbooks.py, you get all the tutorials in the download folder.
