East Baton Rouge Parish recorded 14 murders, 45 rapes, 209 robberies and 225 aggravated assaults in 2017, the most recent year with a full set of crime data. Incidents of property crimes that year include 1,175 thefts, 6,557 thefts of car thefts and 381 motor vehicle thefts. Compared to 2013 figures, the murder rate remained the same in the parish, while rape (200%), aggravated assault (71.8%), theft of burglaries (22.7%) and theft of motor vehicles (178.1%) rates went up. The five-year crime trend in the county also shows that theft (9.5%) theft (22.8%) Rates dropped between 2013 and 2017.Criminal RecordsThe Louisiana State Police Office of Criminal Identification and Information is responsible for providing criminal background checks for all parishes in the state. Provides fingerprint-based criminal background checks. Members of the public can perform internet background checks on the Louisiana State Police website. Using this computer system requires you to register and then log in to the website. Prospective employers may also request criminal background checks by sending applications to the Office of Criminal Identification and Information by mail. To use this method, submit a completed General Disclosure form along with a Completed Authorization form to:Louisiana State PoliceBureau of Criminal Identification and InformationP.O. Box 66614 (Mail Slip A-6)Baton Rouge, LA 70896State and medical boards requesting criminal background checks should file the rap disclosure form instead of the general disclosure form. The Office of Identification and Criminal Information charges a \$26 processing fee for each criminal background check. Acceptable payment methods include cashier's check, money order and preprinted business check. Credit card accepted for in-person payment made at Louisiana.La Sheriff's Office is the main law enforcement agency in East Baton Rouge Parish. It provides criminal and traffic reports on demand through its Records Division. Make your check or money order payable to EBRSO. Louisiana State Police maintains identifying records of convicted sex offenders and predators living in East Baton Rouge Parish and other parishes in the state. Your state-round database can be searched online. Visit the Louisiana Sex Offender Registry and select the East Baton Rouge Parish Sheriff's Office from the list on the page. You can also jump directly to the parish sex offender registry mini-site. There, you can search for sex offenders living in East Baton Rouge Parish by name, phone number, email address, postal address, zip code, and city. The Sheriff's Office runs East Baton Rouge Parish Prison. This correctional centre is located at 2867 Brigadier General Isaac Smith Avenue, Scotland, LA. Your phone number is (225) 355-3311. The Sheriff's Office publishes a regularly updated online inmate list showing current inmates and newly released people from the correctional center. The Department of Prison Inmate Accounts receives money sent to inmates and disburses these funds.
