



CALL FOR GRANTS FOR THE ORGANIZATION OF SCIENTIFIC EVENTS (2021)

Activities eligible for funding:

Events organised by SELIM members whose themes are in the Society's areas of interest and are also officially recognised (i.e. they have been approved by the corresponding universities). The aim is to encourage the promotion of medieval English language and literature by **co-funding** specialised educational promotion or university extension courses, seminars, conferences, summer courses or similar. Regulated courses offered as part of official undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate studies are excluded. The collaboration of SELIM must be stated in the advertising and reports of the events.

Type of funding:

The co-funding is intended to cover the travel and/or accommodation expenses of invited speakers. Social expenses (meals) are specifically excluded, as well as direct payment to speakers.

Deadlines and amount of the grant:

The society issues a single call for applications between 1 February and 28 February 2021 for an event to be carried out until 31 December 2021. A sum of 300 euros per year is set, corresponding to a maximum of two grants. Applications will be processed in order of arrival. The same applicant may not benefit from this grant for two consecutive years, unless there is no other application.

Required documents for submission:

- Duly completed application form.
 - Income and expenditure budget, attaching a certificate of other awarded funding and a detailed budget of the expected expenditure.
 - Certificate stating that it is a regulated activity, approved by the university.

Resolution:

The activities coordinator (second member of the board) will be responsible for the call for and processing of applications. The resolution committee will be made up of the president, the second member and the fourth member of the Society. The result of the co-financing will be informed personally to the applicant within the first quarter of each year. Payment of grants will be made exclusively on presentation of an invoice (for the amount granted) and will be paid by the secretary-treasurer exclusively to the company that has provided the services in question (travel or accommodation) by bank transfer. At the end of each period, the activities coordinator will give an account of the resolution adopted by the committee and the activities financed through this endowment at the Society's ordinary annual assembly.

The Commission for the year 2021 will be formed by Javier Martín Arista (president), Luisa García García (second member) and Miguel Gomes (fourth member).
