He never leaves us to take care of ourselves in a dark world, but reminds us that He is constantly with us, fighting for us even when we cannot see. We destroy arguments and every high opinion raised against the knowledge of God, and take every thought captive to obey Christ (2 Corinthians 10:3-5) Be sober; Be vigilant. Your opponent the devil grows around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to absorb. (1 Peter 5:8) So give yourself to God. Resist the devil and he escape from you. I will say of the Lord: He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, whom I trust. Of course, it will save you from Fowler's trap and from the deadly He will cover you with feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his loyalty will be your shield and shaft. You will not be afraid of the horror of the night, nor the arrow that flies in the afternoon, nor the sea that stalks in the dark, nor the plague that destroys at noon. For he commands his angels about you to guard you in all your ways; they will lift you into their hands so that you do not hit your foot on the stone. You will step on the lion and the cobra; You will trample the great lion and snake. Because he loves me, the Lord says, I will save him; I'm going to protect him because he recognizes my name. He will call me, and I will answer him; I'll be in trouble with him, I'll deliver him and honor him. With a long life, I will satisfy him and show him my salvation. The enemy will use anything and anyone to steal, kill and destroy you (John 10:10). The enemy will even use people close to you. But God gave you armor to help protect yourself. We, the children of God, cannot go to war alone, just as the army does not go to the front line alone. So we must use what God has given us in battle. After all, God is our strength and shield of protection (Psalm 28:7). He will never leave us (Deuteronomy 31:6). God's Victory! In the consent of the Greeks Strong, it says, the phrase full armor means panoplia in Greek. In particular, to have full armor defensive and offensive weapons. According to the research of the words HELPS. God gave us this weapon to give victory over the enemy. Moreover, to fight his victory, not to achieve victory (helps ministries). So why are we at war for the enemy, even our own flesh, to give victory? Let's take a look at a few verses about God's victory: For all who were born of God, the world is overcome. And this is the victory that overcame the world - our faith (1 John 5:4). But thank God for giving us victory through our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Corinthians 15:57). The horse is preparing for the day of battle, but the victory belongs to the Lord (Proverbs 21:31). Often we forget that Jesus Christ has already given us victory over the enemy. The fact is that the enemy and our own desires to assure us that we must fight for victory. Lying tells us that we never had a win in the first place. When Jesus went to the cross and died for us, the enemy was defeated. Jesus himself even gave us power over the enemy. Look, I gave you the right to trample, and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy; nothing will ever hurt you. However, do not rejoice that the spirits obey you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven (10:19-20). All the armor of God! ToH is therefore, by attaching the truth on the belt, and putting on a badge of righteousness, and, like shoes for your feet, wearing the readiness given by the Gospel of peace. In all circumstances, take in a shield of faith with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of evil; and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God... (Ephesian 6:14-17). The Belt of Truth is Jesus, who is constantly searching for him (John 14:6). When your mind is at war, it is very important to look at the Holy Spirit. He will guide you to all truth (John 16:3). The metaphor Paul uses here shows that God's truth will always be around you and keep everything intact. The breast sign of righteousness is to continue to pursue God's righteousness (Matthew 5:6). The McLaren exhibition says: Christ put our feet on a rock, and so the first requirement is secured. If we, for our part, stand close to the gospel that brings peace to our hearts, the peace it brings will make us able to stand and carry the indifferent force that may be cast against us. Defending your faith puts your faith before you as if you were shielding a punch from the enemy. We go by faith, not by vision (2 Corinthians 5:7). We go forward in the armor of faith, because we know that God is already there with us. The helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit are united, because if we do not constantly renew our minds (Romans 12:2), we will be influenced by our own thoughts and desires. Because you have heard of Jesus and learned the truth that comes from him, reset your old sinful nature and your former way of life, which is corrupted by lust and deception. Instead, let the Spirit renew your thoughts and attitudes (Ephesians 4:21-23). They protect against the lies of the enemy because he is the father of lies (John 8:44). Sometimes it is difficult to truly understand the threat that comes from invisible things. However, God warns us that this threat is very real and to arm ourselves with what He has given us.
