INFORMATION WE MAY COLLECT FROM YOU

We may collect and process the following data about you:

- Information we collect about you. With regard to each of your visits to our site we may automatically collect the following information:
 - technical information, including the Internet protocol (IP) address used to connect your computer to the Internet, browser type and version, time zone setting, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform;
 - information about your visit, including the full Uniform Resource Locators (URL) clickstream to, through and from our site (including date and time); page response times, download errors, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks, and mouse-overs), and methods used to browse away from the page.
- Information we receive from other sources. We may also work with third parties (including, for example, business partners, sub-contractors in technical services, advertising networks, analytics providers, search information providers) and may receive information about you from them.

COOKIES

Our website uses cookies and similar technologies, such as Google analytics, to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

USES MADE OF THE INFORMATION

We use information held about you in the following ways:

- Information you give to us. We will use this information:
 - to provide you with any information that you request from us;
 - to (i) provide you with information we feel may interest you; (ii) contact you for marketing and research purposes; and (iii) permit selected third parties to contact you for marketing and networking purposes. If you do not want us to use your data in this way, or to pass your details on to selected third parties for the above purposes, please inform us;
 - to notify you about changes to our company or services; and
 - to ensure that content from our site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer.

• Information we collect about you. We will use this information:

- to administer our site and for internal operations, including troubleshooting, data analysis, testing, research, statistical and survey purposes;

- to improve our site to ensure that content is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer;

- to allow you to participate in any interactive features of our site, when you choose to do so; and

- as part of our efforts to keep our site safe and secure.

• Information we receive from other sources. We may combine this information with information you give to us and information we collect about you. We may use this information and the combined information for the purposes set out above (depending on the types of information we receive).

DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION

We may share your personal information with any member of our corporate group. We may also share your information with selected third parties including:

- suppliers and sub-contractors who provide services to us or on our behalf; and

- analytics and search engine providers that assist us in the improvement and optimisation of our site.

We may disclose your personal information to third parties:

- in the event that we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we may disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets;

- if Touchpaper Innovation Limited or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by it may be one of the transferred assets; and

- if we are under a duty (whether in the UK or any other jurisdiction) to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal or regulatory obligations, or in order to enforce or apply our terms of use <http://touchpaper.org/terms-conditions> and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of Touchpaper Innovation Limited, members of our corporate group, our customers or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

WHERE WE STORE YOUR PERSONAL DATA

The data that we collect from you may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside the European Economic Area ("EEA"). It may also be processed by staff operating outside the EEA who work for us, a member of our corporate group or one of our suppliers. Such staff maybe engaged in, among other things, the provision of support services. By submitting your personal data, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.
