


. One of the unpleasant tasks in preparing for school exams from the point of view of the tutor is the verification of written assignments. In the conditions of distance, this problem has escalated especially. I'll tell you about my experience. Before, I used to send homework through Google Docs. Pre-created the file, threw tasks, then waited for the student to insert his texts there, after proceeding to the check. Vollständig anzeigen... In one tab he opened the criteria, in another the document itself. Inserted a table with points, recorded numbers, highlighted pieces of text with errors, prescribed their types and commented. On the table lay a notebook, where he recorded the number of errors. The tool is convenient, there are no questions, but constantly repeating the same micro-actions - tiring. And I just wanted to check and not think about anything else! In the end, he did at my request a thing that automated most of the routine processes during the check of written homework. I used the tool for a week or two for fun, but then everyone had a forced transition to remote work. Then it became clear that the tool should be urgently expanded: to add items and give to the masses. The service was called CloudText.ru. All the functions that we have done - it is not some sick fantasy of a person detached from the real world, and a specific request for improvement of processes. What the service can do, from the basic: - Automatically counts the number of words in the text; - You do not need to prescribe the types of errors, there are ready-made templates; - Counts errors, points by criteria and The result; - The notification of new works is simple. All! The student has received a notification and can read the result. Now I ask more written assignments to my students, they are more often practiced and in the end will get more points. I have no doubt about that! Believe me, quite a bit, less than you think. Just go to the site, try to check a few works, and then all for yourself will understand - you need it or not. But you should memorize only what is already 100% correct or pre-corrected by the teacher! 7. Already prepared for use phrases, idioms write down and keep in memory in the first person. For example: I am only pulling your leg (I only tease you). 8. Any foreign language cannot be studied in isolation, such as - I will just quietly do exercises in a notebook and listen to the teacher. Watch movies, read literature and newspapers in the original, communicate with English-speaking friends on the Internet!
