



I. Knowing God


Last Sunday we introduced a new 2034 series 4 lessons in Grow Your Faith in the new year To recap on Knowing God:

The 3 Faces of Adams

- 1. the way a person sees himself
- 2. the way others see him
- 3. his true self as God sees him 1 Samuel 16:1-12 Samuel said to Jesse, Are here all your children? He said, There remains yet the youngest, and, behold, he is keeping the sheep... He sent, and brought him in. Now he was ruddy, and withal of a beautiful face, and goodly to look on. Yahweh said, Arise, anoint him; for this is he.

Let us be mindful of Romans 12:3:

For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.



1. Created in God's Image

Genesis 1:27 God created man in his own image. In God's image he created him; male and female he created them.

Of all of God's creation, only man is created in His image

Genesis 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

3. Man is a Free Moral Agent

Genesis 2:16-17 Genesis 2:16-17 Yahweh God commanded the man, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat: but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, you shall not eat of it: for in the day that you eat of it you will surely die."

Not so with angels

As such, we will have to acknowledge while we passionately want to save the lost; they have the right to refuse to heed to our message and suffer the consequences.

4. Tendency to Sin

Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.

When given a choice, the tendency is for man to do evil e.g. put a bunch of boys together

Romans 7:14 For we know that the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin.





5.Empty Without God

Psalms 42:1-2 As the deer pants for the water brooks, So my soul pants after you, God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God.

While mankind has an overwhelminging carnal nature, there is also a powerful spiritual inclination

Example: in mankind's darkest moment, there is no sense or meaning when God is taken out of the picture - e.g. death, 9-11 etc





6. Limited Lifespan

Psalms 90:10 The days of our years are threescore years and ten; and if by reason of strength they be fourscore years

Genesis 2:17 but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, you shall not eat of it: for in the day that you eat of it you will surely die.

Man was made for heaven. While we cannot control the length of our lives, there is much we can do in its breadth and height





7. Every Man Must Face **Eternal Judgment**

2 Corinthians 5:10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ

The only way to escape judgment is to confess our sins and seek cleansing from God

Psalms 103:12 As far as the east is from the west, so $far\ hat h\ he\ removed\ our\ transgressions\ from\ us.$
