From the Pastor:

Greetings from the mission field! I hope this message finds you well. April was a very busy month as we traveled through the United States visiting several churches. We had the opportunity to share about our ministry in Thailand and the vision God has given us. I want to sincerely thank each of you who welcomed us, opened your churches to us, and supported us with your prayers, offerings and encouragement. Your kindness truly means a lot.

Back in Thailand, the ministry has continued to grow. Attendance has been steady, and we've had guest pastors and church members step up to help while I've been away. They've been a great blessing, filling in where needed and keeping the work moving forward.

Through our nonprofit, **Narrow Road Gospel Ministry**, we've begun raising monthly support. My hope and prayer is to transition into full-time pastoral ministry so I can focus fully on shepherding the church and reaching the lost. Right now, my teaching job limits the time I can give to ministry. I believe God is calling us to take this next step, and I'm asking for your help to make it possible. Would you prayerfully consider becoming a monthly supporter? We are asking: **200 people to give \$25/month** or **100 people to give \$50/month**. This support would provide a salary and allow me to serve full-time in the church and community here in Thailand.

We also have some exciting family news! Our son was accepted into **Kyoto University of Advanced Science** in Japan, where he will study business. This is a huge blessing, as he'll be just 5½ hours away from us instead of 24 hours away in the U.S. Please pray for him as we prepare for his move in September.

Thank you all so much for your continued prayers, your giving, and your heart for the Gospel. Thailand remains one of the most unreached areas in Southeast Asia, and your partnership is helping us shine the light of Christ in a dark place. May the Lord bless you richly
