Is This Course For You, and Your Work Place?

This course is for those working in locations where hot and cold water systems can give rise to Legionnaire's Disease risks, e.g. hotels, sports centres, residential/nursing homes, rented property/HMOs, etc., i.e. those with showers or other water spray equipment.

It is suitable for those with day-to-day operational control of water systems who need to understand the hazard and the nature of the relevant controls.

This course will enable delegates to understand

- ◆ The history, significance and symptoms of Legionnaire's Disease
- ◆ The basics of how hot and cold water systems work
- ◆ Risk factors; how the bacterium gets into water systems....
- ◆and the risk factors involved in how it multiplies in the systems, and.....
- ◆the common control measures required to prevent contamination and exposure, and essential monitoring requirements
- ◆ The basics of the legal requirements, and sources of guidance

IMPORTANT! How We Deliver This Course:

1. This is "blended learning" course; in other words, part self-study and part classroom based. So, it is ESSENTIAL that delegates complete 2 or 3 hours' pre-course work before attending the classroom session.
2. A traditional half-day classroom session will follow, to fill in the gaps and make sure the more tricky bits are understood. Delivered in our usual, highly interactive and engaging style (some delegates might even get a little wet.....!)
3. The course is assessed by completing a work book, as we go along in the session.

Assessment Format: Delegates will need to complete a work book, as we progress through the classroom session.
