I'm a huge horror fan, but most of the new horror movies are total trash. This film continues this trend. Below is my review of Lazarus Effect. The film was written by Luke Dawson and Jeremy Slater. Dawson is known for the 2008 horror film Shutter, while Slater is working on the 2015 superhero reboot of Fantastic Four. The plot of the film is a pretty good idea, but the execution is terrible. The movie never knows what kind of horror movie it wants to be. We see a movie jump in and out of a horror subgenre, and to be honest, that totally kills the mood of the movie. The characters themselves are quite wooden and you don't care about them at all. Not only do you not care about the characters, some of the characters are so poorly written, you wonder if Dawson and Slater just threw trash into the wall hoping something would stick. Death clearly doesn't become her as she transforms into a vengeful, Carrie-like figure who begins to waste her colleagues in extremely violent, albeit PG-13-rated, fashion. Becoming less and less interesting as the body count rises and Zoe's eyes turn hellishly black, the film squanders any potential it has had, not to mention the talents of artists such as Duplass and Wilde, who clearly deserve better. More than Harald Swart's Direct Blumhouse Family Horror Film (Exclusive) Director Gelb displays a fairly confident hand in his debut narrative effort, though he relies too heavily on a predictable jump of frightening and repetitive motifs in which the screen turns black for a few seconds before revealing the next terrifying visual.
