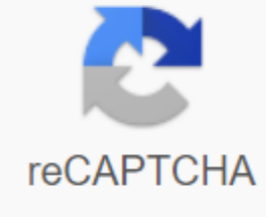

Open the Windows Media Player, which recognizes that the device is connected and registers under the Sync tab at the top. Click on the Sync tab and you'll see the library that's on your MP3 player. You can select individual songs or albums to remove. Just click the right button on a song or album to be removed and scroll down to the Delete option. After choosing Delete, another window will come that says: Are you sure you want to delete (the title of the song)? There are two options at the moment - you can remove only from the library or from the library and computer. Choose one or the other and click The Good button. The song will be removed. The change will appear in the library on the screen. When a player is disconnected from the port, the library will adjust the files to reflect the changes. The player will tell you how to set up the library or some other message to that effect. Once this is over, the main screen will be displayed. Depending on the mp3 player model, there may be a message indicating the library has been updated. Don't turn off the player until the device is recognized and registers the changes you've made.
