

It is one of the branches of the main Malay-Polynesian language family and is similar to the ancient Malay. One of the testimonies of ancient Javanese scriptures is the Tarumanegara Inscription in 450. The oldest example in Java, written in the java language as a whole, is the inscription Sukabumi in 804 AD.
