OVERVIEW

Community Climate Hubs are citizen-led groups focused on accelerating municipal solutions to climate change. Each Hub's mission is to help its municipality reach carbon neutrality as quickly as possible. Hub activities vary according to local priorities, but include convening diverse organizations in support of a common municipal GHG reduction target and building political support for the implementation of prioritized solutions in the service of that target. The National Support Team, led by The Climate Reality Project Canada, develops and curates resources for Hubs. ROs are mandated to support the successful establishment of Hubs in their region.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Playing an active role in their local Hub
- Introducing new members to Hub captains in their community
- Convening monthly calls with captains of each Hub in their region to:
 - Advise on community organizing, government & public relations
 - Connect Hubs with each other & with relevant resources
 - Encourage Hub captains to keep microsites up to date
 - Support Hubs in the implementation of national campaigns
- Relaying needs of Hubs to the National Support Team
- Identifying success stories to be shared across the Hub network
- Reporting progress metrics to the National Support Team
- Recruiting high-potential leaders to apply for Climate Reality trainings
