


# Anna lee' s sexual liberation

The adult DVD segment is dominated by the backstage segment, in which the camera makes impromptu visits with the cast. Pretty standard in its make-up, the behind-the-scenes lens catches performers in their occasional moments and is usually filled with small conversation and clowning around. On the set of Anna Lee, director Jackie St. James chats informally with three of her stars about the film's theme, repressed by sexuality, addressing the issue with seriousness usually not found in the BTS fare. The director, who is also the author of the script, offers ideas in parenting as a factor in sexual relations. Maddie O'Reilly is a leafy Spiegler girl, Maddie O'Reilly resides at the top of the adult food chain industry. Despite her true star status, Maddie admits that her youth was similar to Anna's age: sexually restrained physically but intensely sexy mentally. As something unforeseen can happen, Jackie asks Maddie if she has any concerns that she has been tied up and blindfolded. Maddie admits she was definitely a bit nervous and butterfly. Her level of excitement was sky high; She was heated and sweaty before the sequence was filmed. But, adds Maddie, worrying before shooting sex scenes is normal for her. Why are you shy and nervous about sex? Jackie asks. I'm from a very conservative background, Maddie says. Her childhood was shaped by the religious community in which she lived. There were churches on every corner, Maddie recalls, and going to church three times in there was an expectation that defined the norm in her hometown of the Bible Belt. Photo Courtesy of Jeff Coga Maddie's mother taught her daughter that the simplest physical contact can be misinterpreted as unacceptably sexual and therefore verboten. Hugging someone considered free and not stylish, Maddie speaks with an innocent smile that bespeaks a small town upbringing and once again stresses that attending church outside of the usual Sunday services has strengthened her rural culture of morale. Being so badly affected by religious background, Maddie says, made her escape the southern backwater atmosphere of her childhood. The result? became Maddie's personal release. Entering the adult film business allowed her to break free to do the sexual things she thought about, but didn't have the courage to do as a teenager. In a life of very vanilla home, Maddie comments question-of-fact. People don't talk about sex, ever. Jackie notes that being in a sexually driven business should have been a big change for Maddie considering her upbringing. Absolutely, says the North Carolina native. Because it was so conservative, I wanted to go the exact opposite of it! Maddie O'Reilly laughs and throws out her hands for an accent. My mom and I never talked about sex while I was in business, she exclaims. Today the situation is different, Maddie's mother believes that it is normal to discuss once forbidden with her daughter. One has to wonder if others in Maddie's hometown can succumb to their unspoken curiosity as well as enjoy a little conversation with her. Jackie asks about Anna's appointment, in which she allowed other people to worship her and how it felt from the actress' point of view. Stressing that her co-stars were among her favorite performers in the industry, Maddie insists that not knowing what everyone was going to do with her was interesting. It's a stimulating aspect of doing slavery work I've heard from other performers, though for the record, not everyone adapts to the bandage as easily as Maddie seems to do. Jessa Rhodes and Stephen St. Croix in their behind-the-scenes segment, Jessa Rhodes and Stephen St. Croix discuss another aspect of Anna Lee, their fantasy sex scene with an older man. In the film it is a therapist, Gage, and a young collaborator, Elise. Jessa comments on daddy's fantasy she represents and she speaks from experience. That's my thing, she says, though until recently she thought it was so wrong. Stephen, a veteran of years in business, believes that dad's question is a subtle power figure fantasy as a police officer or teacher. Jessa agrees: It's definitely an authoritative thing for me. User review: After watching dozens of Jackie St. James OK incest-themed vignettes I was happy to hit the pay dirt with what should be her best movie to date, SEXUAL LIBERATION ANNA LEE. This is one of the most impressive new XXX movies I've seen in recent years. The story reminded me of a bit of a classic that was largely forgotten by the great Anthony Spinelli in 1971 TOUCH ME, only Jackie is better than this golden age predecessor. Spinelli deals with sexual group encounters and featured minimal explicit sex, while the new film is set in an unconventional home to treat sexual dysfunction and (according to time) has a maximum amount of XXX action. The great cast of maddie O'Reilly's lead role, Simple Jane, who craves to be able to express herself sexually and advised Dr. Sabato (directed by Jackie in a supporting role) to try out Variel House. The place is run by India's brothers and sisters Summer and Stephen St. Croix (no, despite Jackie's wave of half-brother incest movies, two of them don't get it here), each giving a self-confident, smooth acting performance in addition to their hardcore action. She instructed not to interact with another patient out there, Emmett (Xander Corvus), instantly creating sexual expectations because we that they would eventually jump into the bag. Corvus has a different hang: he pays for sex and wants to have no relationship at all with his partner, an example in a very well-directed scene scene scene prostie Mariel (Natalia Starr), dressed in fishing nets outfit and blindfolded as he dominates her. After his money shot he tells her: I don't have to see your face, and the sequence ends with Starr trudging away at her high heels (to her next assignment) accidentally dropping the bandage to the ground. India and Steven assign their patients daily tasks and Anna Lee is tasked with keeping the video log of her daily thoughts and progress-good cinematic touch that allows her to p-o-in be introduced to the film. These tasks include sensory stimulation and mindfulness (Johnny Castle is quite effective as an assistant whose body and sexual prowess help move Anna Lee forward). Ultimately Maddie and Xander team up to make progress together, but while Anna Lee has a breakthrough, Emmett remains frustrated and eventually leaves until his month-long treatment is completed. His parting note left for Anna Lee is brief: If the pledge, not my thing, good luck ... Setpiece of the film is a complex almost ritual BDSM staging India shackles blindfolded Anna Lee on a big dodgy cross and the staff play with her body, covering her in chocolate, wax candles, honey, etc. and treating her to some s'm light. The entire cast mentioned above rises to the occasion, and so does Jessa Rhodes as Eliza, another assistant who prompts an imaginary sex scene with St. Croix, as Anna Lee is asked to think about how someone else might behave in an interesting early challenge.
